HOUSE BILL 2530

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority;
requiring audit by the State Auditor and Inspector;
prescribing scope of audit; imposing limit for
completion of audit; providing for codification; and
providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1720.1 of Title 69, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

In addition to any other requirement imposed by law with respect
to audits of the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority, the State Auditor and
Inspector shall perform an audit of the Authority at least once each
two (2) years which shall include the two most recently completed
fiscal years of the Authority as of the date the audit begins. The
audit shall be completed not later than ninety (90) days after the
audit begins. Results of the audit shall be transmitted to the
Governor, the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and
the President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State Senate.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
