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12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-1925.5 of Title 63, unless
15	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	A. Beginning July 1, 2021, an assisted living center, as
17	defined in paragraph 1 of Section 1-890.2 of Title 63 of the
18	Oklahoma Statutes, shall be required to have at least ninety-six
19	(96) hours of alternate sources of energy sufficient to maintain
20	facility temperatures through the operation of existing heat and air
21	conditioning systems to protect resident health and safety and for
22	the safe and sanitary storage of food, medicines and other necessary
23	provisions.

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B. Notwithstanding anything in subsection A to the contrary, an
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    assisted living center newly licensed beginning November 1, 2018,
    shall be required to meet the requirements contained in subsection A
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    upon licensure.
        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
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
