AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Retirement System; enacting the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Retirement System Technical Amendments Act of 2018; providing for noncodification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Oklahoma Law Enforcement Retirement System Technical Amendments Act of 2018".

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
