HOUSE BILL 2612

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; prohibiting State Department of Education from creating or modifying mandates that increase costs on public schools unless funding is provided; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-125 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The State Department of Education shall be prohibited from creating a new mandate or modifying an existing mandate in a way that increases costs on public schools or public school districts unless sufficient funding is appropriated by the Legislature or another source of funding is otherwise provided for to pay the costs of the mandate.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.

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
