HOUSE BILL 2653

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to soldiers and sailors; prohibiting members of the Legislature from being employed or entering into contracts with certain private entities contracting or that have contracted with the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs; prohibiting Department employees from being employed or entering into contracts with certain private entities contracting or that have contracted with the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 65.2 of Title 72, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. No member of the Legislature shall, during the term for which he or she was elected or anytime thereafter be employed or be interested in any contract with a private entity or company that is or has been under contract with, provided any services to or assisted the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs.

B. No current or former full-time employee of the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs shall be employed or be interested in

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
