15	Section 90.12. The <del>Third</del> <u>second</u> Monday in <del>November</del> <u>October</u> of
16	each year is <u>hereby</u> designated as "Oklahoma Native American Day" in
17	Oklahoma. All citizens of this state are requested to devote some
18	portion of Oklahoma Native American Day to commemorate the
19	accomplishments of Oklahoma's Native Americans. Teachers and
20	students of the schools of this state are requested to observe the
21	day with appropriate activities.
22	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 2018.
