9	qualify as a master teacher; providing probationary period for master teacher to fulfill educational

13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 382, O.S.L.
15	2016 (10 O.S. Supp. 2017, Section 405.4), is amended to read as
16	follows:
17	Section 405.4 A. Any person with a bachelor's degree or
18	postgraduate degree shall be considered as having met the
19	educational requirements for a director of a full-time child care
20	center required by the Department of Human Services. Nothing in
21	this section shall be construed as to affect annual continuing
22	education requirements. The director of a child care center may
23	also qualify as a master teacher for children of all ages.

Any person employed as a master teacher at a child care center shall be granted a three-year probationary period to fulfill the educational qualifications required by the Department for a master teacher. C. Licensed child care facilities opened or expanded before November 1, 2016, shall have thirty-five (35) square feet of floor area per infant in rooms occupied only by infants. New construction and existing space not previously licensed for child care after November 1, 2016, shall have forty (40) square feet of floor area per infant in rooms occupied only by infants. SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018. 56-2-8176 ΕK 12/13/17
