HOUSE BILL 2749

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public health and safety;
requiring the State Department of Health to contract
with nonprofit organization for certain purpose;
requiring certain review to include one panel member
with certain experience; providing for codification;
and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-1914.17 of Title 63, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The State Department of Health shall contract with a nonprofit
organization to perform informal dispute resolution (IDR) reviews
requested from nursing homes, assisted living facilities and
Intermediate Care Facilities for Individuals with an Intellectual
Disability (ICF/IID). The IDR review shall include at least one
panel member with clinical experience.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
