AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to pediatric cancer; requiring diagnosis of pediatric cancer to be reported based on child's legal address; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-559.2d of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

When a child under the age of eighteen (18) years of age is diagnosed with a form of pediatric cancer, the diagnosis shall be reported as having occurred based on the child's current legal address. The diagnosis shall not be reported as having occurred based on the location of the physician who made such diagnosis.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.

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
