HOUSE BILL 2932

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to poor persons; requiring Oklahoma Health Care Authority to promulgate certain rules; requiring Oklahoma Department of Human Services to eliminate Medicaid eligibility for certain individuals; requiring Authority to seek certain federal approval; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1011.15 of Title 56, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall promulgate rules that eliminates benefits for any nonpregnant able-bodied adult under sixty-five (65) years of age.

B. The Oklahoma Department of Human Services shall eliminate Medicaid eligibility for any nonpregnant able-bodied adult under sixty-five (65) years of age.

1 C. The Authority shall seek any federal approval necessary to
2 implement the provisions of this section.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
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
