AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to definitions and general provisions; designating the red-tailed hawk as the state raptor; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 98.17 of Title 25, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The red-tailed hawk, *Buteo jamaicensis*, is hereby designated and adopted as the state raptor of the State of Oklahoma.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
