HOUSE BILL 3008

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 339, O.S.L. 2017 (47 O.S. Supp. 2017, Section 1135.5), which relates to special license plates; creating the Techlahoma Foundation License Plate; establishing the plate as a financial assistance license plate; providing for design; authorizing plate personalization; authorizing certain licensing agreement; limiting certain payment amounts; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 339, O.S.L. 2017 (47 O.S. Supp. 2017, Section 1135.5), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1135.5 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide financial assistance as provided by this section.

Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of

1 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
2 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
3 registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

4 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
5 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
6 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
7 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
8 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
9 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
10 issued on a staggered system.

11 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
12 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
13 applications for special license plates authorized under this
14 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
15 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
16 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
17 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
18 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
19 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
20 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
21 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
22 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

23 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
24 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,

1 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
2 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
3 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
4 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
5 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
6 removed from the vehicle.

7 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004,
8 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax
9 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid
10 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by
11 the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the
12 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall
13 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are
14 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
15 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

16 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
17 follows:

18 1. University or College Supporter License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such
19 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
20 demonstrate support to any state-supported or private university or
21 college. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
22 collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this
23 title;

1 2. Environmental Awareness License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates
2 shall be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the
3 Tax Commission by the Department of Environmental Quality in
4 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
5 person wishing to demonstrate support to implement the statewide
6 general public environmental education program created pursuant to
7 the provisions of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. Such
8 plates shall be designed and issued to any person in any combination
9 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
10 personalized license plates. A dealer's license plate issued
11 pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be designated
12 an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of the fee
13 imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by
14 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. As provided in
15 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned
16 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title;

17 3. Firefighter License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall be
18 designed for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid.
19 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four
20 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a
21 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an
22 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.
23 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
24 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to

1 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
2 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may
3 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated
4 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon
5 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire
6 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief
7 of the fire department. The license plate shall be designed in
8 consultation with the Oklahoma Firefighters Association.

9 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
10 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &
11 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma State Firefighters Museum
12 and the Oklahoma Fallen and Living Firefighters Memorial;

13 4. Wildlife Conservation License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates
14 shall be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the
15 Tax Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation
16 in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
17 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in
18 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in
19 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may
20 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license
21 plates.

22 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
23 shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of
24 Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

1 5. Child Abuse Prevention License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates
2 shall be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the
3 Tax Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State
4 Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child
5 Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
6 the prevention of child abuse.

7 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
8 shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

9 6. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License ~~Plates~~
10 Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person
11 wishing to demonstrate support for the United States Olympic
12 Committee. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
13 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
14 as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain the
15 official United States Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission
16 shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a licensing
17 agreement with the United States Olympic Committee for any licensing
18 fees which may be required in order to use the United States Olympic
19 Committee logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for
20 a payment of not more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each
21 license plate issued;

22 7. Oklahoma History License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall be
23 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in
24 Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee

1 collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society
2 Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

3 8. Historic Route 66 License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall
4 be designed to honor historic Route 66, also known as the "Mother
5 Road". As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
6 shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society Revolving
7 Fund to be distributed to the Route 66 Museum located in Clinton,
8 Oklahoma;

9 9. Heart of the Heartland License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates
10 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the
11 victims of the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah
12 Federal Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As
13 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
14 deposited in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as
15 established in Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

16 10. Emergency Medical Technician License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such
17 plates shall be designed and issued to any person who is an
18 emergency medical technician. Such persons may apply for an
19 emergency medical technician license plate for each vehicle with a
20 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an
21 emergency medical technician's license. The license plate shall be
22 designed in consultation with the state association of emergency
23 medical technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the
24 fee collected shall be apportioned to the Emergency Medical

1 Personnel Death Benefit Revolving Fund created in Section 1-2505.2
2 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

3 11. Fight Breast Cancer License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates
4 shall be designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and
5 treatment of breast cancer in this state. As provided in this
6 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the
7 Breast Cancer Act Revolving Fund;

8 12. Crime Victims Awareness License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates
9 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
10 awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates
11 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims
12 Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
13 shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for
14 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use
15 such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to
16 provide services to crime victims;

17 13. Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such
18 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
19 demonstrate support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids
20 Association. The license plate shall be designed in consultation
21 with the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. As provided in this
22 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the
23 Children's Hospital - Oklahoma Safe Kids Association Revolving Fund
24 to be distributed to the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association program;

1 14. Four-H Club License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall be
2 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
3 by the Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to
4 demonstrate support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed
5 and issued to any person as for personalized license plates. As
6 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
7 apportioned to the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving
8 Fund created in Section 1104.4 of this title;

9 15. Agricultural Awareness License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates
10 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
11 Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
12 Forestry in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued
13 to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag
14 in the Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an
15 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
16 Section 1104.3 of this title;

17 16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such
18 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
19 commemorate the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in
20 1907. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
21 Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission.
22 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
23 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial
24

1 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of
2 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

3 17. Support Education License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall
4 be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
5 Commission by the State Department of Education in consultation with
6 the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to
7 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license
8 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education ~~License~~
9 license plate in the area of the business accessed by the public.

10 Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be
11 apportioned as follows:

- 12 a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education
13 Reform Revolving Fund,
- 14 b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher
15 Education Revolving Fund,
- 16 c. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State
17 Career Technology Fund, and
- 18 d. eighty-five percent (85%) of the fee shall be
19 deposited to the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund as
20 set forth in Section 17-108 of Title 70 of the
21 Oklahoma Statutes.

22 However, when the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund attains a
23 seventy percent (70%) funded ratio based on an annual actuarial
24 valuation as required by law, the amount of the fee shall be

1 apportioned equally pursuant to subparagraphs a, b and c of this
2 paragraph;

3 18. Retired Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers License ~~Plates~~
4 Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any retired
5 officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol. The license plate shall
6 have the legend "Oklahoma" and shall contain, in the center of the
7 plate, the Highway Patrol Officers patch using the same colors and
8 pattern as used in the patch. Centered on the bottom of the license
9 plate shall be the word "Retired". The letters "TRP" shall be used
10 in combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or
11 emblem. The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown.
12 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
13 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
14 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
15 deceased retired officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, if the
16 spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
17 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a Retired
18 Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers license plate. As provided in this
19 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited into the
20 Law Enforcement Retirement Fund;

21 19. Boy Scouts of America Supporter License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such
22 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
23 demonstrate support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall
24 be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters

1 from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates.
2 The plate shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo.
3 The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into
4 a licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any
5 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts
6 of America logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
7 for a payment to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty
8 Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

9 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License ~~Plates~~ Plate -
10 such plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented
11 to the Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture,
12 Food, and Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in
13 this state that develop and operate programs to encourage urban
14 forestry and beautification, and issued to any person wishing to
15 demonstrate support of such programs. As provided in this section,
16 an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
17 Section 1104.5 of this title;

18 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such
19 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the
20 Tax Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department,
21 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
22 Oklahoma state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the
23 fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and
24 Recreation Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be

1 designated for and may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma
2 state parks;

3 22. Adoption Creates Families License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such
4 plates shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
5 of pregnant women who are committed to placing their children for
6 adoption and wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive
7 parents and other created families to assist in the adoption and
8 placement of children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates
9 shall be designed and final terminology delivered in consultation
10 with the Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human
11 Services. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected shall
12 be deposited in a revolving fund established in the State Treasury
13 for and to be used by the Department of Human Services for the
14 implementation of the Investing in Stronger Oklahoma Families Act
15 specifically for created families;

16 23. Choose Life License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall be
17 designed, subject to criteria presented to the Tax Commission, by
18 Choose Life, Inc., and issued to any person who wishes to
19 demonstrate support of organizations that encourage adoption as a
20 positive choice for women with unplanned pregnancies. As provided
21 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
22 in the Choose Life Assistance Program Revolving Fund established in
23 Section 1104.6 of this title;

1 24. Future Farmers of America License Plate - such plates shall
2 be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
3 the Oklahoma FFA (formerly known as Future Farmers of America). The
4 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
5 FFA Foundation Board of Directors. As provided in this section, an
6 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
7 Section 1104.7 of this title;

8 25. Lions Club License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall be
9 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
10 the Lions Club of Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any
11 person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a
12 maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The license
13 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lions
14 Service Foundation and shall contain the official logo of the
15 International Association of Lions Clubs. The Tax Commission shall
16 be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma
17 Lions Service Foundation. The licensing agreement shall provide for
18 a payment to the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation of not more than
19 Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for each license plate issued;

20 26. Color Oklahoma License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall be
21 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
22 by the Oklahoma Native Plant Society, and issued to any person
23 wishing to demonstrate support for preserving and planting
24 wildflowers and native plants in Oklahoma and to promote Oklahoma's

wildflower heritage through education. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.8 of this title;

27. Girl Scouts of the United States of America Supporter License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Girl Scouts of the United States of America. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain the official Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the Girl Scouts of the United States of America for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Girl Scouts of Magic Empire Council, acting on behalf of all Oklahoma Girl Scout councils, of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

28. Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon. The plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon

1 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
2 Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon logo or design. The licensing
3 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma City Memorial
4 Marathon of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
5 plate issued;

6 29. Oklahoma Scenic Rivers License Plate - such plates shall be
7 designed to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers. The
8 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Scenic
9 Rivers Commission. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee shall be
10 apportioned to the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers Commission;

11 30. Fight Cancer License Plate - such plates shall be designed
12 to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry.
13 The plate shall contain the American Cancer Society logo. The
14 American Cancer Society logo shall be used in accordance with the
15 American Cancer Society's branding guidelines and shall only be
16 utilized to support the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry. Twenty
17 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma
18 Central Cancer Registry Revolving Fund;

19 31. Animal Friendly License Plate - such plates shall be
20 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
21 controlling the overpopulation of dogs and cats through educational
22 and sterilization efforts. The plates shall be designed in
23 consultation with the Veterinary Medical Association. Twenty
24 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee collected shall be designated by the

1 purchaser of the plate to be deposited in the Oklahoma Pet
2 Overpopulation Fund created in Section 2368.13 of Title 68 of the
3 Oklahoma Statutes or the Animal Friendly Revolving Fund created in
4 Section 1104.10 of this title;

5 32. Patriot License Plate - such plates shall be designed in
6 consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma and issued to
7 any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who
8 are members of the Oklahoma National Guard and deployed on active
9 duty. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination
10 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
11 personalized license plates. As provided in this section, a portion
12 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Patriot License Plate
13 Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.11 of this title;

14 33. Global War on Terrorism License Plate - such plate shall be
15 designed in consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma
16 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma
17 residents who are members of the Armed Forces of the United States
18 or Oklahoma National Guard that have served in the Global War on
19 Terrorism. The plate shall be issued to any person in any
20 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six. As
21 provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected shall be
22 deposited in the 45th Infantry Division Museum Fund created in
23 Section 235.1 of Title 44 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

1 34. Boys and Girls Clubs of America Supporter License ~~Plates~~
2 Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person
3 wishing to demonstrate support for the Boys and Girls Clubs of
4 America. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
5 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
6 as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain the
7 official Boys and Girls Clubs of America logo. The Tax Commission,
8 if necessary, may enter into a licensing agreement with the Boys and
9 Girls Clubs of America for any licensing fees which may be required
10 in order to use the Boys and Girls Clubs of America logo or design.
11 The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Boys and
12 Girls Clubs of America of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for
13 each license plate issued;

14 35. Oklahoma Quarter Horse License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates
15 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
16 support for the American Quarter Horse in Oklahoma. The plate shall
17 be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Quarter Horse
18 Association. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee
19 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Quarter Horse Revolving
20 Fund created in Section 1104.12 of this title;

21 36. Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License Plate - such
22 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
23 Association for the Deaf and issued to any person wishing to
24 demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who are deaf. The plates

1 shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and
2 letters from one to maximum of seven, as for personalized license
3 plates. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected
4 shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License
5 Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.15 of this title;

6 37. Oklahoma City Zoo License Plate - such plates shall be
7 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
8 City Zoo. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
9 the Oklahoma Zoological Society, Inc. As provided in this section,
10 an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma
11 Zoological Society Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.13 of this
12 title;

13 38. March of Dimes License Plate - such plates shall be issued
14 to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the March of Dimes
15 mission to improve the health of babies by preventing birth defects,
16 premature birth and infant mortality. The license plates shall be
17 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter March of Dimes.
18 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
