7	An Act relating to professions and occupations; amending 59 O.S. 2011, Section 199.8, as last amended
8	by Section 6, Chapter 260, O.S.L. 2014 (59 O.S. Supp. 2017, Section 199.8), which relates to the Oklahoma
9	Cosmetology and Barbering Act; authorizing certain barbers to create specific curriculum to train
10	apprentices; and providing an effective date.

13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 199.8, as
15	last amended by Section 6, Chapter 260, O.S.L. 2014 (59 O.S. Supp.
16	2017, Section 199.8), is amended to read as follows:
17	Section 199.8 A. Each person training as an apprentice shall
18	be required to have the same qualifications as a student for
19	admission into a cosmetology or barber school, and shall be
20	registered with the State Board of Cosmetology and Barbering before
21	commencing the training.
22	B. No apprentice shall engage in any of the practices of
23	cosmetology or barbering except under the immediate supervision of a

- 1 licensed instructor in a cosmetology or barber establishment 2 approved by the Board for apprentice training.
 - C. All apprentices must wear a badge which designates them as an apprentice and is furnished by the Board with the apprentice registration receipt.
 - D. Only one apprentice may be registered to receive training in any cosmetology or barber establishment at any one time.
 - E. Completion of three thousand (3,000) hours of apprentice training in a cosmetology or barber establishment is the equivalent of one thousand five hundred (1,500) hours' training in a cosmetology or barber school and shall entitle the apprentice to take the examination.
 - E. Notwithstanding any provision of law in this section, a master barber instructor may create a curriculum of no less than one thousand five hundred (1,500) hours, to be approved by the State Board of Cosmetology and Barbering, to train apprentices. Each master barber instructor shall be responsible for the documentation and expenses of the training. Completion of apprentice training pursuant to this subsection shall entitle the apprentice to take the examination.
- 21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
