HOUSE BILL 3011

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to professions and occupations;
amending 59 O.S. 2011, Section 199.8, as last amended
by Section 6, Chapter 260, O.S.L. 2014 (59 O.S. Supp.
2017, Section 199.8), which relates to the Oklahoma
Cosmetology and Barbering Act; authorizing certain
barbers to create specific curriculum to train
apprentices; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 199.8, as
last amended by Section 6, Chapter 260, O.S.L. 2014 (59 O.S. Supp.
2017, Section 199.8), is amended to read as follows:

Section 199.8 A. Each person training as an apprentice shall
be required to have the same qualifications as a student for
admission into a cosmetology or barber school, and shall be
registered with the State Board of Cosmetology and Barbering before
commencing the training.

B. No apprentice shall engage in any of the practices of
cosmetology or barbering except under the immediate supervision of a

1 licensed instructor in a cosmetology or barber establishment
2 approved by the Board for apprentice training.

3 C. All apprentices must wear a badge which designates them as
4 an apprentice and is furnished by the Board with the apprentice
5 registration receipt.

6 ~~D. Only one apprentice may be registered to receive training in~~
7 ~~any cosmetology or barber establishment at any one time.~~

8 ~~E.~~ Completion of three thousand (3,000) hours of apprentice
9 training in a cosmetology or barber establishment is the equivalent
10 of one thousand five hundred (1,500) hours' training in a
11 cosmetology or barber school and shall entitle the apprentice to
12 take the examination.

13 E. Notwithstanding any provision of law in this section, a
14 master barber instructor may create a curriculum of no less than one
15 thousand five hundred (1,500) hours, to be approved by the State
16 Board of Cosmetology and Barbering, to train apprentices. Each
17 master barber instructor shall be responsible for the documentation
18 and expenses of the training. Completion of apprentice training
19 pursuant to this subsection shall entitle the apprentice to take the
20 examination.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
