6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to public property; establishing
8 certain limitation on the use of government property
9 for certain purposes; providing exception; providing
10 for codification; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 334 of Title 61, unless there is
14 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 Political subdivisions of the state shall not sublet or
16 otherwise allow occupancy of public property for use as office space
17 for day-to-day business operations to organizations that engage in
18 collective bargaining. Nothing shall prohibit such organizations
19 from using such facilities for meetings or storage of documents.

20 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
