17	A. Any employee of the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs
18	may be granted administrative leave with pay for volunteer service
19	activities under such terms and limitations as the Executive
20	Director of the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs may
21	establish, in service to veterans or dependents of veterans in the
22	state of Oklahoma that meet one or more of the following criteria:
23	1. The activity is directly related to the Department's

- 2. The activity is sponsored or sanctioned by or in partnership with the Department; or
  - 3. The activity will enhance the development or skills of the employee in his or her current position.
  - B. Leave shall be as brief as permitted under the circumstances and shall not support an activity that would otherwise be prohibited by law while in a duty status.
  - C. The Executive Director shall establish guidelines for approval of administrative leave for volunteer service authorized hereunder which balance the Department's goals and operations and ensure that all are conducted efficiently and effectively.
- 12 | SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
