AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to labor; prohibiting specific entities from terminating certain employees; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 198.3 of Title 40, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any person, partnership, corporation, limited liability company or legal entity of any kind that contracts with the State of Oklahoma and accepts tax credits or tax incentives of any kind shall be prohibited from terminating an employee based on sexual orientation.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
