AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to Oklahoma House of Representatives;  
establishing a sexual harassment prevention program;  
providing for codification; and providing an  
effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 465 of Title 74, unless there is  
created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Oklahoma House of Representatives shall implement a sexual  
harassment prevention program, including developing and posting a  
comprehensive written sexual harassment policy, and providing  
training on sexual harassment prevention and the sexual harassment  
policy. All members, employees, staff, pages and interns of the  
Oklahoma House of Representatives shall be provided sexual  
harassment training, and such training shall be a component of all  
ongoing or new employee training programs.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
