HOUSE BILL 3176

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to agriculture; amending 2 O.S. 2011, Section 7-414, which relates to the Oklahoma Milk and Milk Products Act; allowing for certain incidental sales and advertising of raw milk; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 2 O.S. 2011, Section 7-414, is amended to read as follows:

Section 7-414. A. The provisions of the Oklahoma Milk and Milk Products Act shall not be construed to:

1. Include incidental sales of raw milk directly to consumers at the farm where the milk is produced;

2. Include incidental sales of raw milk by the farm producer sold directly to the consumer at a farmers' market as defined by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry; provided any unpasteurized milk shall be clearly labeled by the producer as "unpasteurized raw milk";

1 3. Preclude the advertising of the incidental sales of raw

5 ~~3.~~ 5. Prohibit any farmer or producer from making cheese using
6 milk or cream produced on the farm of such farmer or producer.

7 B. For purposes of this section, incidental sales of goat milk
8 are those sales where the average monthly number of gallons sold
9 does not exceed one hundred (100).

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
