15	Section 7-414. A. The provisions of the Oklahoma Milk and Milk
16	Products Act shall not be construed to:
17	1. Include incidental sales of raw milk directly to consumers
18	at the farm where the milk is produced;
19	2. Include incidental sales of raw milk by the farm producer
20	sold directly to the consumer at a farmers' market as defined by the
21	Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry; provided any
22	unpasteurized milk shall be clearly labeled by the producer as
23	"unpasteurized raw milk";

5	3. 5. Prohibit any farmer or producer from making cheese using
6	milk or cream produced on the farm of such farmer or producer.
7	B. For purposes of this section, incidental sales of goat milk
8	are those sales where the average monthly number of gallons sold
9	does not exceed one hundred (100).
10	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
