HOUSE BILL 3219

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to poor persons; amending 56 O.S. 2011, Section 1011.10, which relates to Oklahoma Medicaid Reform Act of 2006; increasing age limit eligibility for certain health care benefits; expanding type of students to receive health care benefits under Oklahoma Health Care Authority waiver application; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 56 O.S. 2011, Section 1011.10, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1011.10 The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall apply for any necessary waiver to extend health care benefits to persons up to the age of ~~twenty-three (23)~~ twenty-six (26) years if the person is enrolled as a full-time student in an accredited university or college, a course of instruction or training operated by the Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education or any educational institution offering a certification or licensure course in the State of Oklahoma.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
