HOUSE BILL 3229

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to insurance; prohibiting insurer from terminating, refusing to issue or renew a physician contract under certain circumstances; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6057.7 of Title 36, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

An insurer issuing health benefit plans in this state shall not terminate, refuse to issue or renew a contract with a physician participating in a preferred provider organization network for the reason that the physician provided the person insured under the health benefit plan a referral or name of another physician not participating in a preferred provider organization network.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.

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
