AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public health and safety;  
requiring State Department of Health to promulgate  
certain rules; providing for codification; and  
providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-546.6 of Title 63, unless  
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The State Department of Health shall promulgate rules that  
require pregnant women who are prescribed opiates for greater than  
five (5) days to receive pain management services.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
