14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2011, Section 4-103.1, as
16	last amended by Section 1, Chapter 326, O.S.L. 2016 (26 O.S. Supp.
17	2017, Section 4-103.1), is amended to read as follows:
18	Section 4-103.1 A. A qualified elector may apply to register
19	to vote or update a registration to vote by:
20	1. Delivering by mail or otherwise a completed voter
21	registration application to the State Election Board or any county

2. Completing a voter registration application in person with any official of an agency described in Section 4-109.2 of this title;

- 3. Completing a voter registration application in person as part of an application for issuance, renewal or change of address for a driver license or issuance of a state identification card issued pursuant to Section 6-105 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes with a designated representative of the Department of Public Safety; or
- 4. Completing a voter registration application electronically as provided in Section 4-109.4 of this title.
- B. The secretary of the county election board for the county of the applicant's residence shall send to each applicant by nonforwardable, first-class United States mail a notice of the disposition of the application. Notice mailing costs shall be paid by the county. Provided, the Secretary of the State Election Board may authorize such notices to be sent by electronic means for voter registration applications submitted electronically.
- C. Effective January 1, 2020, a qualified elector applying to register to vote or updating a registration to vote shall provide proof of citizenship to the State Election Board or any county election board. For the purposes of this subsection, proof of citizenship shall be provided by any one of the following documents:

1 1. A legible photocopy of the applicant's birth certificate 2 that verifies citizenship to the satisfaction of the State Election 3 Board;

- 2. A legible photocopy of pertinent pages of the person's United States passport identifying the person and the person's passport number or presentation to the State Election Board of the person's United States passport;
- 3. A legible photocopy of the person's United States naturalization documents or the number of the certificate of naturalization. If only the number of the certificate of naturalization is provided, the person shall not be permitted to register until the number of the certificate of naturalization is verified with United States Citizenship and Immigration Services by the State Election Board;
- 4. Other documents or methods of proof of citizenship that are established pursuant to the Immigration Reform and Control Act of 1986, P.L. 99-603, 100 Stat. 3359; or
- 5. The persons' Bureau of Indian Affairs card number, tribal treaty card number or tribal enrollment number.
- NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified SECTION 2. in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7-114.1 of Title 26, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
- 23 A. Effective January 1, 2020, in addition to the requirements provided by Section 7-114 of Title 26 of the Oklahoma Statutes, each

- person appearing to vote shall provide proof of citizenship. For the purposes of this subsection, proof of citizenship shall be provided by any one of the following documents:
 - 1. A legible photocopy of the applicant's birth certificate that verifies citizenship to the satisfaction of the judge of the precinct;
 - 2. A legible photocopy of pertinent pages of the person's
 United States passport identifying the person and the person's
 passport number or presentation to the judge of the precinct of the
 person's United States passport;
 - 3. A legible photocopy of the person's United States naturalization documents or the number of the certificate of naturalization. If only the number of the certificate of naturalization is provided, the person shall not be permitted to vote until the number of the certificate of naturalization is verified with United States Citizenship and Immigration Services by the judge of the precinct;
 - 4. Other documents or methods of proof of citizenship that are established pursuant to the Immigration Reform and Control Act of 1986, P.L. 99-603, 100 Stat. 3359; or
 - 5. The persons' Bureau of Indian Affairs card number, tribal treaty card number or tribal enrollment number.
