HOUSE BILL 3344

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to poor persons; requiring Oklahoma Health Care Authority to promulgate certain rules; requiring Oklahoma Department of Human Services to eliminate Medicaid eligibility for certain individuals; requiring Authority to seek certain federal approval; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1011.15 of Title 56, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall promulgate rules that eliminate benefits for any nonpregnant, able-bodied adult under sixty-five (65) years of age.

B. The Oklahoma Department of Human Services shall eliminate Medicaid eligibility for any nonpregnant, able-bodied adult under sixty-five (65) years of age.

C. The Authority shall seek any federal approval necessary to implement the provisions of this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
