HOUSE BILL 3363

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to state government; prohibiting agencies from eliminating certain programs; requiring notice of elimination or reduction in certain programs; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3117.1 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. No agency, constitutionally or statutorily created state board, bureau, commission, office, authority, public trust in which the state is a beneficiary or interstate commission shall eliminate or reduce programs impacting children, seniors or public safety unless specifically mandated or approved by the Legislature.

B. Prior to the elimination or reduction of a program impacting children, seniors or public safety, the agency, constitutionally or statutorily created state board, bureau, commission, office, authority, public trust in which the state is a beneficiary or

1 interstate commission shall notify, in writing, the Governor, the
2 Speaker of the House of Representatives, the Administrative Rule
3 Review Committee and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate of the
4 intended action. The notice shall include justification for the
5 elimination or reduction of the program and all supportive
6 documentation.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
