7 An Act relating to motor vehicles; authorizing
8 certain contract with private vendor for marketing
9 and sales of certain personalized and special license
10 plates; authorizing the establishment of fees by
11 rule; providing criteria for establishment of fee
12 amounts; providing fees be in addition to other fees;
13 limiting contract payment amounts; authorizing the
14 creation of additional license plate designs and
15 color combinations; providing that such designs
16 remain the property of the Tax Commission; forbidding
17 certain interpretations of certain statutory
18 language; authorizing the cancellation of certain
19 license plates, designs and color combination;
20 providing for deposit of certain funds under certain
21 conditions; providing certain contractual
22 requirements and limitations; forbidding certain
23 license plate marketing and sales; amending 47 O.S.
24 2011, Sections 1135.2, as last amended by Section 12,
Chapter 54, O.S.L. 2015, 1135.3, as last amended by
Section 2, Chapter 331, O.S.L. 2017, and 1135.5, as
last amended by Section 3, Chapter 331, O.S.L. 2017
(47 O.S. Supp. 2017, Sections 1135.2, 1135.3 and
1135.5), which relate to special license plates;
authorizing multi-year renewals; providing that fee
be calculated on a per-year-of-renewal basis;
amending 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.4, which relates
to personalized license plates; authorizing multi-
year renewals; providing that fee be calculated on a
per-year-of-renewal basis; providing for
codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW

A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1135.9 of Title 47, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is authorized to enter into a contract with a private vendor experienced in the marketing and sale of:

1. Personalized license plates authorized under Section 1135.4 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and

2. Special license plates authorized under Sections 1135.2, 1135.3, 1135.5 and 1135.7 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

B. 1. The Commission shall establish by rule administrative fees for license plates issued and renewed under the provisions of subsection A of this section. The administrative fees authorized by this paragraph shall be reasonable but not less than the amounts necessary for the Commission to recover costs to the Commission associated with the:

- a. awarding of the contract authorized by this section,
- b. implementation and enforcement of such contract, and
- c. direct and indirect administrative costs associated with administering the provisions of this section.

2. The fees authorized by this subsection shall be in addition to all other registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act, including the fees required by

1 Sections 1135.2, 1135.3, 1135.4, 1135.5 and 1135.7 of Title 47 of
2 the Oklahoma Statutes.

3 C. 1. The contracted amount payable to a private vendor
4 related to the marketing and sale of personalized license plates
5 shall only be payable from amounts derived from administrative fees
6 associated with the issuance and renewal of such personalized
7 license plates.

8 2. The contracted amount payable to a private vendor related to
9 the marketing and sale of special license plates shall only be
10 payable from amounts derived from administrative fees associated
11 with the issuance and renewal of such special license plates.

12 D. 1. The Commission may approve additional designs and color
13 combinations for personalized and nonpersonalized license plates
14 that may be marketed and sold by a private vendor under a contract
15 entered into under the provisions of this section. Each approved
16 license plate design and color combination shall remain the property
17 of the Commission.

18 2. The Commission may approve additional designs and color
19 combinations for special license plates authorized under the
20 provisions of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes, including for
21 special license plates that may be personalized, that may be
22 marketed and sold by a private vendor under a contract entered into
23 under the provisions of this section. Each approved license plate
24

1 design and color combination shall remain the property of the
2 Commission.

3 3. This subsection shall not be interpreted to authorize:

4 a. the Commission to approve a design or color
5 combination for a specialty license plate, or

6 b. the private vendor to market or sell a special license
7 plate with a design or color combination,

8 that is inconsistent with the design or color combination specified
9 for the license plate in the special license plate's authorizing
10 statute.

11 E. The Commission shall not:

12 1. Publish a proposed design or color combination for a special
13 license plate for public comment, except on the Commission's website
14 for a period not to exceed ten (10) days;

15 2. Restrict the background color, color combinations or color
16 alphanumeric license plate numbers of a special license plate,
17 except as determined by the Department of Public Safety as necessary
18 for law enforcement purposes;

19 3. Restrict the private vendor from conducting reasonable
20 events or auctions;

21 4. Restrict the right of the private vendor to offer a variety
22 of plate categories with both personalized and nonpersonalized
23 patterns; or
24

1 5. Unreasonably disapprove or limit the ability for the private
2 vendor to offer plate terms that exceed one (1) year.

3 F. The Commission may cancel a license plate or require the
4 discontinuation or redesign of a license plate design or color
5 combination that is marketed and sold by a private vendor under
6 contract at any time if the Department determines that the
7 cancellation or discontinuation is in the best interest of the state
8 or the motoring public.

9 G. To the extent fees collected under the provisions of this
10 section are in excess of the total amounts provided in subparagraphs
11 a, b and c of paragraph 1 of subsection B of this section, the
12 excess amount shall be deposited to the credit of the General
13 Revenue Fund.

14 H. 1. A contract entered into with a private vendor under the
15 provisions of this section shall provide for the Commission to
16 recover all costs incurred by the Commission in implementing the
17 provisions of this section. Under the provisions of the contract,
18 the Commission may require the private vendor to reimburse the
19 Commission in advance for:

- 20 a. not more than one-half (1/2) of the Commission's
- 21 anticipated costs in initiating the contract, and
- 22 b. the Commission's anticipated costs in coordinating the
- 23 introduction of a new special license plate.

1 2. The initial term of contract entered into under the
2 provisions of this section shall be no less than five (5) years in
3 duration. Such contract may provide for additional terms at least
4 equal in length to the initial term of the contract.

5 I. As applied to contracts entered under the provisions of this
6 section, the Commission shall not:

7 1. Unreasonably disapprove or limit any aspect of a private
8 vendor's marketing and sales plan; or

9 2. Unreasonably interfere with the selection, assignment or
10 management by the private vendor of the private vendor's employees,
11 agents or subcontractors.

12 J. A private vendor shall not market and sell license plates
13 that compete directly for sales with other special license plates
14 issued under the provisions of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes,
15 unless the Commission and the agency or organization associated with
16 the special license plate authorizes such marketing and sale.

17 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.2, as
18 last amended by Section 12, Chapter 54, O.S.L. 2015 (47 O.S. Supp.
19 2017, Section 1135.2), is amended to read as follows:

20 Section 1135.2 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
21 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
22 plates to persons in recognition of their service or awards as
23 provided by this section.

1 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
2 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
3 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
4 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
5 registered for the current year.

6 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
7 Commission or a motor license agent, unless authorized by the Tax
8 Commission to be renewed for a period greater than one (1) year.

9 The Tax Commission shall ~~annually~~ notify by mail all persons issued
10 special license plates. The notice shall contain all necessary
11 information and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure
12 upon presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax Commission.
13 The license plates shall be issued on a staggered system except for
14 legislative plates and amateur radio operator license plates.

15 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
16 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
17 applications for special license plates authorized under this
18 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
19 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
20 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
21 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
22 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
23 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
24 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for

1 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
2 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

3 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
4 follows:

5 1. Prisoner of War License Plates - such plates shall be
6 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United
7 States Armed Forces and civilians who were former prisoners of war
8 held by a foreign country and who can provide proper certification
9 of that status. Such persons may apply for a prisoner of war
10 license plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having
11 a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving
12 spouse of any deceased former prisoner of war, if the spouse has not
13 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by
14 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a prisoner of war
15 license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
16 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
17 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
18 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
19 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

20 2. National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
21 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma National
22 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
23 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
24 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

1 3. Air National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma Air National
3 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
4 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
5 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

6 4. United States Armed Forces - such plates shall be designed
7 for active, retired, former or reserve members of the United States
8 Armed Forces, and shall identify which branch of service, and carry
9 the emblem and name of either the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or
10 Coast Guard, according to the branch of service to which the member
11 belongs or did belong. Former members who have been dishonorably
12 discharged shall not be eligible for such plates. Persons applying
13 for such license plate must show proof of present or past military
14 service by presenting a valid Uniformed Services Identity Card or
15 the United States Department of Defense Form (DD)214. Retired or
16 former members who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof
17 of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required
18 to provide proof of eligibility annually;

19 5. Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient License Plates - such
20 plates shall be designed for any resident of this state who has been
21 awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor. Such persons may apply
22 for a Congressional Medal of Honor recipient license plate for each
23 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
24 There shall be no registration fee for the issuance of this plate;

1 6. Missing In Action License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who are
3 missing in action. The spouse of such missing person, if the spouse
4 has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
5 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, and each parent of the
6 missing person may apply for a missing in action license plate upon
7 presenting proper certification that the person is missing in action
8 and that the person making the application is the qualifying spouse
9 or the parent of the missing person. The qualifying spouse and each
10 parent of the missing person may each apply for the missing in
11 action license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
12 of one (1) ton or less;

13 7. Purple Heart Recipient License Plates - such plates shall be
14 designed for any resident of this state presenting proper
15 certification from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs
16 or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that such
17 resident has been awarded the Purple Heart military decoration.
18 Such persons may apply for a Purple Heart recipient license plate
19 for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
20 less. The surviving spouse of any deceased veteran who has been
21 awarded the Purple Heart military decoration, if such spouse has not
22 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage has been terminated
23 by death, divorce or annulment, may apply for such plate for one
24 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The

1 license plate created by this paragraph shall be exempt from the fee
2 provided by this section for special license plates;

3 8. Pearl Harbor Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
5 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
6 the United States as being:

7 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on December
8 7, 1941,

9 b. stationed on December 7, 1941, during the hours of
10 7:55 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. Hawaii time at Pearl Harbor,
11 the island of Oahu, or offshore at a distance not to
12 exceed three (3) miles, and

13 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
14 States Armed Forces.

15 Such person may apply for a Pearl Harbor Survivor license plate
16 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
17 less;

18 9. Iwo Jima License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
19 any resident of this state who can be verified by the United States
20 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United
21 States as being:

22 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces in February
23 of 1945,

1 b. stationed in February of 1945 on or in the immediate
2 vicinity of the island of Iwo Jima, and

3 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
4 States Armed Forces.

5 Such person may apply for an Iwo Jima license plate for each
6 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

7 Such license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK" and shall
8 contain three letters and three numbers. Between the letters and
9 numbers shall be a logo of the flag-raising at Iwo Jima. Below the
10 letters, logo and numbers, the plate shall contain the words "FEB."
11 at the left, "Iwo Jima" in the center and "1945" at the right. Such
12 plates shall not be subject to the design requirements of any other
13 license plates prescribed by law other than the space for the
14 placement of the yearly decals for each succeeding year of
15 registration after the initial issue;

16 10. D-Day Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
17 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
18 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
19 the United States as being:

20 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on June 6,
21 1944,

22 b. a participant in the Allied invasion of the coast of
23 Normandy on June 6, 1944; provided, if such
24 participation cannot be verified by the United States

1 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
2 the United States, the Tax Commission may, in its
3 discretion, accept evidence of such participation from
4 the person applying for the license plate, and

5 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
6 States Armed Forces.

7 Such person may apply for a D-Day Survivor license plate for
8 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

9 11. Killed in Action License Plates - such plates shall be
10 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were
11 killed in action. The spouse of the deceased person, if the spouse
12 has not remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by
13 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a killed in action
14 license plate upon presenting proper certification that the person
15 was killed in action and that the person making the application is
16 the qualifying spouse of the deceased person. The qualifying spouse
17 may apply for a killed in action license plate for no more than two
18 vehicles with each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1)
19 ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
20 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
21 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
22 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

23 12. Gold Star Parents License Plates - such plates shall be
24 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were

1 killed during a war. The parents of the deceased person may apply
2 for a gold star license plate upon presenting proper certification
3 that the person was killed during a war and that the person making
4 the application is the parent of the deceased person. The parent
5 may apply for a gold star parent license plate for no more than two
6 vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one
7 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
8 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
9 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
10 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

11 13. Military Decoration License Plates - such plates shall be
12 designed for any resident of this state who has been awarded the
13 Distinguished Service Medal, the Distinguished Service Cross, the
14 Distinguished Flying Cross, the Bronze Star military decoration or
15 the Silver Star military decoration. Such persons may apply for a
16 military decoration license plate for each vehicle with a rated
17 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

18 14. Vietnam Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
19 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United
20 States Armed Forces who served in the Vietnam Conflict. Such
21 persons may apply for a Vietnam veteran license plate for each
22 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

23 15. Police Officer License Plates - such plates shall be
24 designed for any currently employed, reserve or retired municipal

1 police officer or full-time, reserve or retired university police
2 officer certified by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and
3 Training or common education police officer certified by the Council
4 on Law Enforcement Education and Training. Police officers may
5 apply for police officer license plates for vehicles with a rated
6 capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon proof of
7 employment by or retirement from a municipal, university or common
8 education police department by either an identification card or
9 letter from the chief of the police department or the Oklahoma
10 Police Pension and Retirement Board. Retirees who are eligible for
11 such plates shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial
12 application, but shall not be required to provide proof of
13 eligibility annually. The license plates shall be designed in
14 consultation with municipal police departments of this state;
15 provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design
16 to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in
17 order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate;

18 16. World War II Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
19 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United
20 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be
21 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of
22 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having
23 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from
24 September 16, 1940, to December 7, 1945. The former members may

1 apply for a World War II Veteran license plate for vehicles with a
2 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

3 The license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma" and shall
4 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia
5 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold
6 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, U.S. Army Air Corps,
7 Marines or Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which
8 the member belonged. For the purpose of license plate
9 identification, the plate shall contain four digits, two digits at
10 the left and two digits at the right of the insignia or emblem.
11 Centered on the bottom of the license plate shall be the words
12 "WORLD WAR II";

13 17. Korean War Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
14 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United
15 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be
16 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of
17 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having
18 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from June
19 27, 1950, to January 31, 1955, both dates inclusive. The former
20 members may apply for a Korean War Veteran license plate for
21 vehicles with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

22 The license plate shall have the legend "OKLAHOMA" and shall
23 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia
24 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold

1 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or
2 Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which the member
3 belonged. For the purpose of license plate identification, the
4 plate shall contain four digits, two digits at the left and two
5 digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. Centered on the
6 bottom of the license plate shall be the word "KOREA";

7 18. Municipal Official License Plates - such plates shall be
8 designed for persons elected to a municipal office in this state and
9 shall designate the name of the municipality and the district or
10 ward in which the municipal official serves. The plates shall only
11 be produced upon application;

12 19. Red Cross Volunteer License Plates - such plates shall be
13 designed to honor American Red Cross volunteers and staff who are
14 residents of this state. Such persons must present an
15 identification card issued by the American Red Cross and bearing a
16 photograph of the person. The license plate shall be designed with
17 the assistance of the American Red Cross and shall have the legend
18 "Oklahoma OK!" in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the legend the
19 symbol of the American Red Cross and no more than three letters and
20 three numbers shall be in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the
21 symbol and letters and numbers shall be the words "American Red
22 Cross" in black. The plates shall not be subject to the design
23 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other
24

1 than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each
2 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue;

3 20. Veterans of Foreign Wars License Plates - such plates shall
4 be designed to honor the veterans of foreign wars and issued to any
5 resident of this state who is a member of a Veterans of Foreign Wars
6 organization in this state. Such persons may apply for Veterans of
7 Foreign Wars license plates upon proof of membership in a Veterans
8 of Foreign Wars organization. The license plate shall be designed
9 in consultation with the Veterans of Foreign Wars organization;

10 21. Desert Storm License Plates - such plates shall be designed
11 and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of the
12 United States Armed Forces who served in the Persian Gulf Crisis and
13 the Desert Storm operation. Such persons may apply for a Desert
14 Storm license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
15 of one (1) ton or less;

16 22. Military Reserve Unit License Plates - such plates shall be
17 designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of
18 a reserve unit of the United States Armed Forces. Such persons may
19 apply for a Military Reserve Unit license plate for each vehicle
20 with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

21 23. Oklahoma City Bombing Victims and Survivors License Plates
22 - such plates shall be designed and issued to any victim or survivor
23 of the bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building in
24 downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995;

1 24. Civil Air Patrol License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed and issued to any person who is a member of the Civil Air
3 Patrol. Such persons may apply for a Civil Air Patrol license plate
4 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
5 less upon proof of membership in the Civil Air Patrol. The license
6 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Civil Air Patrol;

7 25. Ninety-Nines License Plates - such plates shall be designed
8 and issued to members of the Ninety-Nines. Persons applying for
9 such license plate must show proof of membership in the Ninety-
10 Nines. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
11 the Ninety-Nines;

12 26. Combat Infantryman Badge License Plates - such plates shall
13 be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Infantryman Badge.
14 The plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK". Below the legend
15 shall be the Combat Infantryman Badge and three numbers. Below the
16 badge and the numbers shall be the words "Combat Infantryman Badge".
17 Such persons may apply for a Combat Infantryman Badge license plate
18 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
19 less;

20 27. Somalia Combat Veterans License Plates - such plates shall
21 be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member
22 of the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in the United
23 Nations relief effort. Such persons may apply for a Somalia Combat
24

1 Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
2 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

3 28. Police Chaplain License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed and issued to members of the International Conference of
5 Police Chaplains (ICPC) who have completed the ICPC requirements for
6 basic certification as a police chaplain. The license plates shall
7 be designed in consultation with the ICPC;

8 29. Joint Service Commendation Medal License Plates - such
9 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state
10 who has been awarded the Joint Service Commendation Medal by the
11 United States Secretary of Defense;

12 30. Merchant Marine License Plates - such plates shall be
13 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
14 by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs, and issued to any
15 person who during combat was a member of the Merchant Marines as
16 certified by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs. Such
17 license plate may be issued for each vehicle with a rated carrying
18 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

19 31. Legislative License Plates - such plates shall be designed
20 for persons elected to the Oklahoma Legislature and shall designate
21 the house of the Legislature in which the legislator serves and the
22 district number;

23 32. Disabled Veterans License Plates - such plates shall be
24 designed for persons presenting proper certification from the United

1 States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the
2 United States certifying such veteran has a service-connected
3 disability rating of fifty percent (50%) or more, regardless which
4 agency pays the disability benefits, or that such veteran has been
5 awarded a vehicle by the United States government or receives a
6 grant from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs for the
7 purchase of an automobile due to a service-connected disability
8 rating or due to the loss of use of a limb or an eye. Such persons
9 may apply to the Tax Commission for a disabled veterans license
10 plate or to a motor license agent for a regular license plate for no
11 more than two vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying
12 capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving spouse of any
13 deceased disabled veteran, if the spouse has not since remarried, or
14 if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by death, divorce, or
15 annulment, or a surviving spouse in receipt of Dependency and
16 Indemnity Compensation from the United States Department of Veterans
17 Affairs, may apply for a disabled veterans license plate for one
18 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
19 fee provided by this section for the special license plate
20 authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other
21 registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees
22 levied by Section 1132 of this title. The total expense of this
23 license plate shall not exceed Five Dollars (\$5.00).

24

1 If the person qualifies for a disabled veterans license plate
2 and is also eligible for a physically disabled placard under the
3 provisions of Section 15-112 of this title, the person shall be
4 eligible to receive a disabled veterans license plate that also
5 displays the international accessibility symbol, which is a stylized
6 human figure in a wheelchair. Upon the death of the disabled
7 veteran with a disabled veterans license plate with the
8 international accessibility symbol, the plate shall be returned to
9 the Tax Commission;

10 33. United States Air Force Association License Plates - such
11 plates shall be designed for members of the United States Air Force
12 Association. Persons applying for such license plate must show
13 proof of membership in the Association. The license plates shall be
14 designed in consultation with the Association;

15 34. Oklahoma Military Academy Alumni License Plates - such
16 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state
17 who is an alumnus of the Oklahoma Military Academy. Such persons
18 may apply for an Oklahoma Military Academy Alumnus license plate for
19 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
20 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
21 Oklahoma Military Academy and shall contain the shield of the
22 Academy;

23 35. Amateur Radio Operator License Plates - such plates shall
24 be designed and issued to any person, holding a valid operator's

1 license, technician class or better, issued by the Federal
2 Communications Commission, and who is also the owner of a motor
3 vehicle currently registered in Oklahoma, in which has been
4 installed amateur mobile transmitting and receiving equipment.
5 Eligible persons shall be entitled to two special vehicle
6 identification plates as herein provided. Application for such
7 identification plates shall be on a form prescribed by the Tax
8 Commission and the plates issued to such applicant shall have
9 stamped thereon the word "Oklahoma" and bear the official call
10 letters of the radio station assigned by the Federal Communications
11 Commission to the individual amateur operator thereof. All
12 applications for such plates must be made to the Tax Commission on
13 or before the first day of October of any year for such plates for
14 the following calendar year and must be accompanied by the fee
15 required in this section together with a certificate, or such other
16 evidence as the Tax Commission may require, of proof that applicant
17 has a valid technician class or better amateur operator's license
18 and proof of applicant's ownership of a vehicle in which radio
19 receiving and transmitting equipment is installed. Applicants shall
20 only be entitled to one set of special identification plates in any
21 one (1) year, and such calendar year shall be stamped thereon. The
22 right to such special identification plates herein provided for
23 shall continue until the amateur radio operator's license of the
24 person to whom such plates are issued expires or is revoked;

1 36. American Legion License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed for members of the American Legion. Persons applying for
3 such license plate must show proof of membership. The license
4 plates shall be designed in consultation with the American Legion of
5 Oklahoma;

6 37. Deputy Sheriff License Plates - such plates shall be
7 designed for any currently employed or retired county sheriff or
8 deputy sheriff. County sheriffs or deputy sheriffs may apply for
9 such plates for vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or
10 less upon proof of employment by or retirement from a county
11 sheriff's office by either an identification card or letter from the
12 county sheriff or a government-sponsored retirement board from which
13 the county sheriff or deputy sheriff may be receiving a pension.
14 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
15 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
16 provide proof of eligibility annually. The license plates shall be
17 designed in consultation with the county sheriff offices of this
18 state;

19 38. Gold Star Surviving Spouse License Plates - such plates
20 shall be designed to honor the surviving spouses and children of
21 qualified veterans. As used in this paragraph, "qualified veteran"
22 shall mean:

- 23 a. any person honorably discharged from any branch of the
24 United States Armed Forces or as a member of the

Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a direct result of the performance of duties for any branch of the United States Armed Forces or Oklahoma National Guard while on active military duty, or

- b. any person honorably discharged from any branch of the United States Armed Forces or as a member of the Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a result of injury, illness or disease caused by the performance of such duties while on active duty, whether the death occurred while on active duty or after the honorable discharge of such person.

The fee provided by this section for the special license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

39. Korea Defense Service Medal License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who has been awarded the Korea Defense Service Medal by the United States Secretary of Defense. Such persons may apply for a Korea Defense Service Medal license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

40. 180th Infantry License Plates - such plates shall be designed for members and prior members of the 180th Infantry.

Persons applying for such license plate must obtain and provide

1 proof of their membership from the 180th Infantry Association. The
2 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the 180th
3 Infantry;

4 41. Operation Iraqi Freedom Veteran License Plates - such
5 plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or
6 present member of the United States Armed Forces who served in
7 Operation Iraqi Freedom. Such person may apply for an Operation
8 Iraqi Freedom Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated
9 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

10 42. United States Air Force Academy Alumni License Plates -
11 such plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this
12 state who is an alumnus of the United States Air Force Academy.
13 Such persons may apply for a United States Air Force Academy Alumnus
14 license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
15 (1) ton or less;

16 43. Operation Enduring Freedom Veteran License Plate - such
17 plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or
18 present member of the United States Armed Forces who served in
19 Operation Enduring Freedom on or after September 11, 2001. The
20 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Military
21 Department of the State of Oklahoma. Such person may apply for an
22 Operation Enduring Freedom Veteran license plate for each vehicle
23 with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

1 44. Military Multi-Decoration License Plate - such plates shall
2 be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member
3 of the United States Armed Forces who qualifies for more than one
4 military decoration license plate pursuant to the provisions of this
5 section. The Tax Commission shall develop and implement a system
6 whereby the designs of the eligible license plates can be included
7 together on a single license plate. Such person may apply for a
8 Military Multi-Decoration license plate for each vehicle with a
9 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

10 45. Global War on Terror Expeditionary License Plate - such
11 plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or
12 present member of the United States Armed Forces who has earned a
13 Global War on Terror Expeditionary decoration. The license plate
14 shall be designed in consultation with the United States Institute
15 of Heraldry and the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma.
16 Such person may apply for a Global War on Terror Expeditionary
17 license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
18 (1) ton or less;

19 46. Legion of Merit Medal Recipient License Plates - such
20 plates shall be designed for any resident of this state presenting
21 proper certification from the United States Department of Veterans
22 Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that
23 such resident has been awarded the Legion of Merit military
24 decoration. Such persons may apply for a Legion of Merit recipient

1 license plate for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one
2 (1) ton or less. The license plate shall be designed in
3 consultation with the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma;

4 47. 1-179th License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
5 members, prior members and members of the household of a member or
6 former member of the 1-179th Infantry. Persons applying for such
7 license plate must obtain and provide proof of their membership
8 association with the 1-179th Infantry Association. The license
9 plate shall be designed in consultation with the 1-179th Infantry;

10 48. 2-179th License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
11 members, prior members and members of the household of a member or
12 former member of the 2-179th Infantry. Persons applying for such
13 license plate must obtain and provide proof of their membership
14 association with the 2-179th Infantry Association. The license
15 plate shall be designed in consultation with the 2-179th Infantry;

16 49. Combat Action Ribbon Recipient License Plates - such plates
17 shall be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Action Ribbon
18 who present proper certification from the United States Department
19 of the Navy. The license plate shall include the Combat Action
20 Ribbon earned by the recipient. Such persons may apply for a Combat
21 Action Ribbon Recipient license plate for vehicles having a rated
22 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

23 50. Oklahoma Submarine Veterans License Plate - such plates
24 shall be designed for any resident of this state who is a United

1 States submarine veteran and presents either a Department of Defense
2 form 214 or other documentation certifying such service. Such
3 persons may apply for an Oklahoma Submarine Veterans license plate
4 for vehicles having a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
5 license plate design shall include both gold and silver dolphins to
6 represent both officer and enlisted service members; and

7 51. United States Navy Seabees and Civil Engineer Corps License
8 Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably
9 discharged or present member of the United States Navy Seabees or
10 Civil Engineer Corps. Such persons may apply for a United States
11 Navy Seabees and Civil Engineer Corps license plate for vehicles
12 having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
13 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Military
14 Department of the State of Oklahoma.

15 C. Unless otherwise provided by this section, the fee for such
16 plates shall be Eight Dollars (\$8.00) per year of renewal and shall
17 be in addition to all other registration fees provided by the
18 Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. Such fees shall be
19 deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be
20 used for the administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
21 Registration Act.

22 SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.3, as
23 last amended by Section 2, Chapter 331, O.S.L. 2017 (47 O.S. Supp.
24 2017, Section 1135.3), is amended to read as follows:

1 Section 1135.3 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
2 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
3 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support, interest, or
4 membership to or for an organization, occupation, cause or other
5 subject as provided by this section.

6 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
7 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
8 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
9 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
10 registered for the current year.

11 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
12 Commission or a motor license agent, unless authorized by the Tax
13 Commission to be renewed for a period greater than one (1) year.

14 The Tax Commission shall ~~annually~~ notify by mail all persons issued
15 special license plates. The notice shall contain all necessary
16 information and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure
17 upon presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax Commission.
18 The license plates shall be issued on a staggered system.

19 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
20 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
21 applications for special license plates authorized under this
22 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
23 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
24 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary

1 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
2 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
3 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
4 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
5 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
6 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

7 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
8 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
9 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
10 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
11 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
12 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
13 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
14 removed from the vehicle.

15 Except as otherwise provided in ~~this section~~ law, for special
16 license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004, no special
17 license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax Commission
18 until the Commission receives one hundred (100) prepaid applications
19 therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by the Tax
20 Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the effective
21 date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall be null
22 and void. In the event one hundred (100) prepaid applications are
23 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
24 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

1 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
2 follows:

3 1. Round and Square Dance License Plate - such plates shall be
4 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
5 round and square dancing;

6 2. National Association for the Advancement of Colored People

9 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the NAACP;

10 3. National Rifle Association License Plate - such plates shall
11 be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
12 Commission by the National Rifle Association, and issued to any
13 person wishing to demonstrate support for the National Rifle
14 Association;

15 4. Masonic Fraternity License Plate - such plates shall be
16 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of
17 a Masonic Fraternity of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a
18 Masonic Fraternity license plate for each vehicle with a rated
19 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Masonic
20 Fraternity membership or upon the presentment of an application for
21 a Masonic Fraternity license plate authorized and approved by the
22 Grand Lodge of Oklahoma. The license plates shall be designed in
23 consultation with the Masonic Fraternities of Oklahoma and shall
24 contain the Masonic emblem;

1 5. Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children License
2 Plate - such plates shall be designed to demonstrate support for
3 Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children and shall be
4 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Shriner's
5 Temple in Oklahoma. The license plate shall be designed in
6 consultation with the Shriner's Temples in Oklahoma and shall
7 contain the Shriner's emblem;

8 6. Balloonists License Plate - such plates shall be designed
9 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for hot air
10 ballooning in this state;

11 7. Order of the Eastern Star License Plate - such plates shall
12 be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member
13 of an Order of the Eastern Star. Such persons may apply for an
14 Order of the Eastern Star license plate for each vehicle with a
15 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an
16 Order of the Eastern Star membership or upon the presentment of an
17 application for an Order of the Eastern Star license plate
18 authorized and approved by the organization. The license plate
19 shall be designed in consultation with the Order of the Eastern Star
20 and shall contain the Order of the Eastern Star emblem;

21 8. Knights of Columbus License Plate - such plates shall be
22 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of
23 the Knights of Columbus. Such persons may apply for a Knights of
24 Columbus license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying

1 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Knights of Columbus
2 membership or upon the presentment of an application for a Knights
3 of Columbus license plate authorized and approved by the
4 organization. The license plate shall be designed in consultation
5 with the Knights of Columbus and shall contain the Knights of
6 Columbus emblem;

7 9. Jaycees License Plate - such plates shall be designed and
8 issued to members of the Jaycees. Persons applying for such license
9 plate must show proof of membership in the Jaycees. The license
10 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Jaycees;

11 10. Kiwanis International License Plate - such plates shall be
12 designed and issued to members of Kiwanis International. Persons
13 applying for such license plate must show proof of membership in
14 Kiwanis International. The license plates shall be designed in
15 consultation with Kiwanis International;

16 11. Certified Public Accountants License Plate - such plates
17 shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a
18 Certified Public Accountant. Such persons may apply for a Certified
19 Public Accountant license plate for each vehicle with a rated
20 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of status as a
21 Certified Public Accountant. The license plates shall be designed
22 in consultation with the Oklahoma Society of Certified Public
23 Accountants;

1 12. Civil Emergency Management License Plate - such plates
2 shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate
3 support for the state civil emergency management system. Persons
4 applying for such license plate must show proof of official
5 affiliation by presenting a nonexpired proof of employment,
6 affiliation or retirement in the form of an identification card or
7 letter on official letterhead from a municipal, county or state
8 emergency management department head;

9 13. Civilian Conservation Corps License Plate - such plates
10 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
11 Commission, by the Civilian Conservation Corps Association, and
12 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Civilian
13 Conservation Corps;

14 14. Rotarian License Plate - such plates shall be designed and
15 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Rotarian
16 Club of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a Rotarian license
17 plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton
18 or less upon proof of a Rotarian Club membership or upon the
19 presentment of an application for a Rotarian license plate
20 authorized and approved by a Rotarian Club of Oklahoma. The license
21 plates shall be designed in consultation with the five Rotarian
22 District Governors and shall contain the Rotarian emblem;

23 15. Benevolent Protective Order of Elks License Plate - such
24 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the

1 Tax Commission, by the Benevolent Protective Order of Elks, and
2 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of the
3 Benevolent Protective Order of Elks;

4 16. Humane Society License Plate - such plates shall be
5 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
6 the Humane Society of the United States. The plates shall be issued
7 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to
8 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate
9 shall contain the official Humane Society logo;

10 17. Oklahoma Mustang Club License Plate - such plates shall be
11 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission,
12 by the Oklahoma Mustang Club, and issued to any resident of this
13 state who is a member of the Oklahoma Mustang Club. Such persons
14 may apply for an Oklahoma Mustang Club license plate upon
15 presentment of proof of membership in the Oklahoma Mustang Club.
16 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of
17 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
18 personalized license plates;

19 18. American Business Clubs (AMBUCS) License Plate - such
20 plates shall be designed and issued to members of American Business
21 Clubs. Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of
22 membership in AMBUCS. The license plates shall be designed in
23 consultation with American Business Clubs;

1 19. West Point 200th Anniversary License Plate - such plates
2 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate
3 the Two Hundredth Anniversary of the founding of the United States
4 Military Academy at West Point, New York. The license plates shall
5 be designed in consultation with the West Point Society of Central
6 Oklahoma;

7 20. Oklahoma Aquarium License Plate - such plates shall be
8 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
9 the Oklahoma Aquarium. The license plates shall be designed in
10 consultation with the Oklahoma Aquarium;

11 21. The Pride of Broken Arrow License Plate - such plates shall
12 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
13 for The Pride of Broken Arrow marching band. The plates shall be
14 designed in consultation with the Broken Arrow Public School System;

15 22. Fellowship of Christian Athletes License Plate - such
16 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Fellowship of
17 Christian Athletes and issued to members and supporters of the
18 Fellowship of Christian Athletes;

19 23. Parrothead Club License Plate - such plates shall be
20 designed and issued to members and supporters of the Parrothead
21 Club. The license plate shall be issued to any person in any
22 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven as
23 for personalized license plates;

1 24. Oklahoma Bicycling Coalition License Plate - such plates
2 shall be designed and issued to any person who is a member of the
3 Oklahoma Bicycling Coalition. The license plates shall be designed
4 in consultation with the Oklahoma Bicycling Coalition;

5 25. Electric Lineman License Plate - such plates shall be
6 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
7 Oklahoma's electric linemen. The license plates shall be designed
8 in consultation with the Oklahoma Electric Superintendent's
9 Association;

10 26. Alpha Kappa Alpha License Plate - such plates shall be
11 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Alpha Kappa
12 Alpha Sorority. The license plates shall be designed in
13 consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha
14 Sorority;

15 27. The National Pan-Hellenic Council Incorporated License
16 Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person
17 wishing to demonstrate support to any of the nine sororities and
18 fraternities recognized by the National Pan-Hellenic Council
19 Incorporated. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
20 with the Oklahoma Chapter of the National Pan-Hellenic Council
21 Incorporated;

22 28. Organ, Eye and Tissue License Plate - such plates shall be
23 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support and
24 increase awareness for organ, eye and tissue donation. The license

1 plates shall be designed in consultation with the State Department
2 of Health;

3 29. Central Oklahoma Habitat for Humanity License Plate - such
4 plates shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to
5 demonstrate support and increase awareness for Habitat for Humanity.
6 The license plate shall be designed in consultation with Central
7 Oklahoma Habitat for Humanity;

8 30. Family Career and Community Leaders of America Incorporated
9 License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to persons
10 wishing to demonstrate support for Family Career and Community
11 Leaders of America Incorporated. The license plates shall be
12 designed in consultation with Family Career and Community Leaders of
13 America Incorporated;

14 31. Delta Sigma Theta License Plate - such plates shall be
15 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Delta Sigma
16 Theta Sorority. The license plates shall be designed in
17 consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority
18 Incorporated;

19 32. Omega Psi Phi License Plate - such plates shall be designed
20 and issued to any person who is a member of Omega Psi Phi
21 Fraternity. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
22 with the Oklahoma Chapter of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity Incorporated;

23 33. Alpha Phi Alpha License Plate - such plates shall be
24 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Alpha Phi Alpha

1 Fraternity. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
2 with the Oklahoma Chapter of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity
3 Incorporated;

4 34. 50th Anniversary of the Interstate System of Highways
5 License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to persons
6 wishing to commemorate the 50th Anniversary of the Interstate System
7 of Highways. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
8 with the American Association of State Highway and Transportation
9 Officials;

10 35. Kappa Alpha Psi License Plate - such plates shall be
11 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Kappa Alpha Psi
12 Fraternity. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
13 with the Oklahoma Chapter of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity
14 Incorporated;

15 36. Sigma Gamma Rho License Plate - such plates shall be
16 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Sigma Gamma Rho
17 Sorority. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
18 the Oklahoma Chapter of Sigma Gamma Rho Sorority Incorporated.
19 Subject to the provisions of subsection A of this section, the Sigma
20 Gamma Rho License Plate is hereby reauthorized effective November 1,
21 2013;

22 37. Multiple Sclerosis License Plate - such plates shall be
23 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
24 and increase awareness of multiple sclerosis. The license plates

1 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of the
2 National Multiple Sclerosis Society;

3 38. Frederick Douglass High School License Plate - such plates
4 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
5 support for Frederick Douglass High School located in Oklahoma City.
6 The plates shall be designed in consultation with representatives of
7 Frederick Douglass High School National Alumni Association;

8 39. United States Air Force Academy License Plate - such plates
9 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate

11 40. In God We Trust License Plate - such plates shall be
12 designed to include the motto, "In God We Trust", and shall be
13 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the motto;

14 41. National Weather Center License Plate - such plates shall
15 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
16 for the National Weather Center in Norman. The plates shall be
17 designed in consultation with representatives of the National
18 Weather Center Directors;

19 42. Make-A-Wish Foundation License Plate - such plates shall be
20 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
21 the Make-A-Wish Foundation. The license plates shall be designed in
22 consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of the National Make-A-Wish
23 Foundation;

1 43. South Central Section PGA Foundation License Plate - such
2 plates shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to
3 demonstrate support for the South Central Section PGA Foundation.
4 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the South
5 Central Section PGA Foundation;

6 44. Putnam City High School License Plate - such plates shall
7 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
8 for Putnam City High School. The plates shall be designed in
9 consultation with representatives of Putnam City High School Alumni
10 Association, Inc.;

11 45. Autism Awareness License Plate - such plates shall be
12 designed and issued to any person wishing to increase awareness of
13 autism. The license plate shall be designed in consultation with
14 the Oklahoma Autism Network;

15 46. Oklahoma Blood Institute License Plate - such plates shall
16 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
17 for the Oklahoma Blood Institute. The license plates shall be
18 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Blood Institute;

19 47. Zeta Phi Beta and Phi Beta Sigma License Plate - such
20 plates shall be designed and issued to any person who is a member of
21 Zeta Phi Beta Sorority or Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity. The license
22 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma chapters
23 of Zeta Phi Beta Sorority Incorporated and Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity
24 Incorporated;

1 48. Star Spencer High School License Plate - such plates shall
2 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
3 for Star Spencer High School located in Oklahoma City. The plates
4 shall be designed in consultation with representatives of the Star
5 Spencer High School Alumni Association. Subject to the provisions
6 of subsection A of this section, the Star Spencer High School
7 License Plate is hereby reauthorized effective November 1, 2015;

8 49. Northeast High School License Plate - such plates shall be
9 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
10 Northeast High School located in Oklahoma City. The plates shall be
11 designed in consultation with representatives of the Northeast High
12 School Alumni Association;

13 50. Oklahoma City Central High School License Plate - such
14 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
15 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Central High School Alumni
16 Association. The plates shall be designed in consultation with
17 representatives of the Oklahoma City Central High School Alumni
18 Association;

19 51. Historic Greenwood District License Plate - such plates
20 shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for music
21 festivals held in the Historic Greenwood District in Tulsa,
22 Oklahoma. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
23 the Greenwood Cultural Center;

1 52. Oklahoma Rifle Association License Plate - such plates
2 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
3 support for the Oklahoma Rifle Association. The plates shall be
4 designed in consultation with representatives of the Oklahoma Rifle
5 Association;

6 53. Oklahoma City Thunder License Plate - such plates shall be
7 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
8 the Oklahoma City Thunder. The license plate shall be designed in
9 consultation with the Oklahoma City Thunder organization;

10 54. Ovarian Cancer Awareness License Plate - such plates shall
11 be designed and issued to any person wishing to increase awareness
12 of ovarian cancer. The license plate shall be designed in
13 consultation with the HOPE in Oklahoma organization;

14 55. BMW Car Club of America License Plate - such plates shall
15 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
16 for the BMW Car Club of America. The plates shall be issued to any
17 person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a
18 maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The license
19 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Sunbelt Chapter of
20 the BMW Car Club of America. Subject to the provisions of
21 subsection A of this section, the BMW Car Club of America License
22 Plate is hereby reauthorized effective November 1, 2013;

23 56. Don't Tread On Me License Plate - such plates shall be
24 designed to include the yellow background and rattlesnake emblem

1 above the motto "DON'T TREAD ON ME" as found on the historic Gadsden
2 flag, and shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
3 support for the freedom and liberty of the Republic;

4 57. Oklahomans for the Arts License Plate - such plates shall
5 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
6 for arts, culture and creative industries as well as arts education.
7 The plates shall be designed in consultation with Oklahomans for the
8 Arts;

9 58. Oklahoma City Barons License Plate - such plates shall be
10 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
11 the Oklahoma City Barons. The license plate shall be designed in
12 consultation with the Oklahoma City Barons organization. The
13 license plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of
14 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six;

15 59. Oklahoma City Redhawks License Plate - such plates shall be
16 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
17 the Oklahoma City Redhawks. The license plate shall be designed in
18 consultation with the Oklahoma City Redhawks organization;

19 60. Tulsa Shock License Plate - such plates shall be designed
20 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
21 Tulsa Shock. The license plate shall be designed in consultation
22 with the Tulsa Shock organization;

23 61. Tulsa Oilers License Plate - such plates shall be designed
24 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the

1 Tulsa Oilers. The license plate shall be designed in consultation
2 with the Tulsa Oilers organization;

3 62. Tulsa Drillers License Plate - such plates shall be
4 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
5 the Tulsa Drillers. The license plate shall be designed in
6 consultation with the Tulsa Drillers organization;

7 63. Millwood School District License Plate - such plates shall
8 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
9 for the Millwood School District. The license plate shall be
10 designed in consultation with representatives of the Millwood School
11 District;

12 64. Booker T. Washington High School License Plate - such
13 plates shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
14 Booker T. Washington High School and shall be designed in
15 consultation with the Booker T. Washington High School National
16 Alumni Association;

17 65. Oklahoma Current State Flag License Plate - such plates
18 shall be designed to include the current Oklahoma state flag and
19 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the current
20 Oklahoma state flag. The plates shall be designed in consultation
21 with the Friends of the Oklahoma History Center;

22 66. Oklahoma Original State Flag License Plate - such plates
23 shall be designed to include the original Oklahoma state flag and
24 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the original

Oklahoma state flag. The plates shall be designed in consultation with the Friends of the Oklahoma History Center. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized plates. Subject to the provisions of subsection A of this section, the Oklahoma Original State Flag license plate is hereby reauthorized effective November 1, 2015;

67. Tulsa 66ers License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Tulsa 66ers. The plates shall be designed in consultation with the Tulsa 66ers Organization;

68. Frederick Bombers License Plate - such plates shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Frederick School District and shall be designed in consultation with representatives of the Frederick School District;

69. 911 Dispatcher License Plate - such plates shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for 911 dispatchers. Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of current employment as a 911 dispatcher or sign an attestation that they are a currently employed or retired 911 dispatcher;

70. Oklahoma Fosters License Plate - such plates shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Fosters Initiative and shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Fosters Initiative; and

1 71. Red Dirt Jeeps - such plates shall be designed and issued
2 to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Red Dirt Jeeps and
3 such plates shall be designed in consultation with Red Dirt Jeeps,
4 L.L.C.

5 C. The fee for such plates shall be Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00)
6 per year of renewal and shall be in addition to all other
7 registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
8 Registration Act. Unless otherwise provided in this section, the
9 fee shall be apportioned as follows: Eight Dollars (\$8.00) per year
10 of renewal of the special license plate fee shall be deposited in
11 the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the
12 administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act
13 and the remaining Seven Dollars (\$7.00) per year of renewal of the
14 special license plate fee shall be apportioned as provided in
15 Section 1104 of this title.

16 SECTION 4. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.4, is
17 amended to read as follows:

18 Section 1135.4 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
19 authorized to design and issue personalized license plates. The
20 personalized license plates shall be issued on a staggered system
21 except for vintage decals.

22 Personalized special license plates shall not be transferred to
23 any other person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer
24 of ownership and retained. The personalized special license plate

1 may then be used on another vehicle but only after such other
2 vehicle has been registered for the current year.

3 Personalized special license plates shall be renewed each year
4 by the Tax Commission or a motor license agent, unless authorized by
5 the Tax Commission to be renewed for a period greater than one (1)
6 year. The Tax Commission shall ~~annually~~ notify by mail all persons
7 issued special license plates. The notice shall contain all
8 necessary information and shall contain instructions for the renewal
9 procedure upon presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax
10 Commission. The motor license agent fees for renewals shall be paid
11 out of the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

12 B. Such plates shall be designed and issued for the following:

13 1. Any person in any combination of numbers or letters from one
14 to a maximum of seven;

15 2. Persons eligible for two or more of the military decoration
16 special license plates provided for in Title 47 of the Oklahoma
17 Statutes. Such plates may be issued in any combination of emblems.
18 However, such plates shall only display up to three emblems and
19 shall also display any combination of letters or numbers from one to
20 a maximum of three;

21 3. Motorcycles in any combination of numbers or letters from
22 one to a maximum of six;

23 4. Persons eligible for Korean War Veteran license plates
24 provided for in Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may

1 display any combination of letters or numbers up to three on each
2 side of the insignia or emblem;

3 5. Persons eligible for World War II Veteran license plates
4 provided for in Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may
5 display any combination of letters or numbers up to three on each
6 side of the insignia or emblem; and

7 6. Persons owning vehicles which are twenty-one (21) years and
8 older are qualified to submit for approval by the Tax Commission or
9 a motor license agent a vintage but expired official Oklahoma
10 license plate which is twenty-one (21) years and older. Upon
11 approval of such personalized plate, the owner shall be issued the
12 annual registration decal which the Tax Commission or agent shall
13 direct to be affixed.

14 C. The fee for such plates shall be Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) per
15 year of renewal and shall be in addition to all other registration
16 fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act.
17 Eight Dollars (\$8.00) per year of renewal of the personalized tag
18 fee shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement
19 Fund to be used for the administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle
20 License and Registration Act. Twelve Dollars (\$12.00) per year of
21 renewal of the personalized tag fee shall be apportioned as provided
22 in Section 1104 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

1 SECTION 5. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as
2 last amended by Section 3, Chapter 331, O.S.L. 2017 (47 O.S. Supp.
3 2017, Section 1135.5), is amended to read as follows:

4 Section 1135.5 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
5 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
6 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide
7 financial assistance as provided by this section.

8 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
9 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
10 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
11 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
12 registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

13 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
14 Commission or a motor license agent, unless authorized by the Tax
15 Commission to be renewed for a period greater than one (1) year.

16 The Tax Commission shall ~~annually~~ notify by mail all persons issued
17 special license plates. The notice shall contain all necessary
18 information and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure
19 upon presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax Commission.
20 The license plates shall be issued on a staggered system.

21 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
22 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
23 applications for special license plates authorized under this
24 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's

1 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
2 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
3 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
4 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
5 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
6 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
7 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
8 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

9 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
10 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
11 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
12 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
13 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
14 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
15 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
16 removed from the vehicle.

17 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004,
18 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax
19 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid
20 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by
21 the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the
22 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall
23 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are
24

1 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
2 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

3 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
4 follows:

5 1. University or College Supporter License Plate - such plates
6 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
7 support to any state-supported or private university or college. As
8 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
9 apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this title;

10 2. Environmental Awareness License Plate - such plates shall be
11 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
12 Commission by the Department of Environmental Quality in
13 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
14 person wishing to demonstrate support to implement the statewide
15 general public environmental education program created pursuant to
16 the provisions of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. Such
17 plates shall be designed and issued to any person in any combination
18 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
19 personalized license plates. A dealer's license plate issued
20 pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be designated
21 an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of the fee
22 imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by
23 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. As provided in
24

1 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned
2 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title;

3 3. Firefighter License Plate - such plates shall be designed
4 for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid.

5 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four
6 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a
7 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an
8 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.

9 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
10 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
11 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
12 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may
13 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated
14 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon
15 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire
16 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief
17 of the fire department. The license plate shall be designed in
18 consultation with the Oklahoma Firefighters Association.

19 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
20 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &
21 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighters Museum and
22 the Oklahoma Fallen and Living Firefighters Memorial;

23 4. Wildlife Conservation License Plate - such plates shall be
24 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax

Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license plates.

As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

5. Child Abuse Prevention License Plate - such plates shall be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the prevention of child abuse.

As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

6. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the United States Olympic Committee. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain the official United States

1 Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if
2 necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the United
3 States Olympic Committee for any licensing fees which may be
4 required in order to use the United States Olympic Committee logo or
5 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not
6 more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate
7 issued;

8 7. Oklahoma History License Plate - such plates shall be
9 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in
10 Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
11 collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society
12 Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

13 8. Historic Route 66 License Plate - such:

14 a. vehicle plates shall be designed to honor historic
15 Route 66, also known as the "Mother Road". As
16 provided in this section, an amount of the fee
17 collected for each vehicle license plate shall be
18 apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society
19 Revolving Fund to be distributed to the Route 66
20 Museum located in Clinton, Oklahoma, and

21 b. motorcycle plates shall be designed in consultation
22 with the Oklahoma Route 66 Association, Inc. The
23 Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
24 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Route 66

1 Association, Inc., for any licensing fees which may be
2 required in order to use the Oklahoma Route 66
3 Association, Inc., logo or design. The licensing
4 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma
5 Route 66 Association, Inc., of not more than Twenty
6 Dollars (\$20.00) for each motorcycle license plate
7 issued;

8 9. Heart of the Heartland License Plate - such plates shall be
9 designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the victims of
10 the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal
11 Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As provided
12 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
13 in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in
14 Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

15 10. Emergency Medical Technician License Plate - such plates
16 shall be designed and issued to any person who is an emergency
17 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical
18 technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
19 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an emergency medical
20 technician's license. The license plate shall be designed in
21 consultation with the state association of emergency medical
22 technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
23 collected shall be apportioned to the Emergency Medical Personnel
24

1 Death Benefit Revolving Fund created in Section 1-2505.2 of Title 63
2 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

3 11. Fight Breast Cancer License Plate - such plates shall be
4 designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of
5 breast cancer in this state. As provided in this section, an amount
6 of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Breast Cancer Act
7 Revolving Fund;

8 12. Crime Victims Awareness License Plate - such plates shall
9 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
10 awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates
11 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims
12 Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
13 shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for
14 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use
15 such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to
16 provide services to crime victims;

17 13. Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License Plate - such plates
18 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
19 support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. The
20 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
21 Safe Kids Association. As provided in this section, an amount of
22 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Children's Hospital -
23 Oklahoma Safe Kids Association Revolving Fund to be distributed to
24 the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association program;

1 14. Four-H Club License Plate - such plates shall be designed,
2 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the
3 Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
4 support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed and issued
5 to any person as for personalized license plates. As provided in
6 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to
7 the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving Fund created in
8 Section 1104.4 of this title;

9 15. Agricultural Awareness License Plate - such plates shall be
10 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission,
11 by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in
12 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
13 person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag in the
14 Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an amount
15 of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section
16 1104.3 of this title;

17 16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plate - such plates
18 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate
19 the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. The
20 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
21 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. As
22 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
23 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial
24

1 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of
2 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

3 17. Support Education License Plate - such plates shall be
4 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
5 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the
6 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to
7 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license
8 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate
9 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three
10 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as
11 follows:

- 12 a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education
13 Reform Revolving Fund,
- 14 b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher
15 Education Revolving Fund,
- 16 c. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State
17 Career Technology Fund, and
- 18 d. eighty-five percent (85%) of the fee shall be
19 deposited to the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund as
20 set forth in Section 17-108 of Title 70 of the
21 Oklahoma Statutes.

22 However, when the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund attains a
23 seventy percent (70%) funded ratio based on an annual actuarial
24 valuation as required by law, the amount of the fee shall be

1 apportioned equally pursuant to subparagraphs a, b and c of this
2 paragraph;

3 18. Retired Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers License Plate -
4 such plates shall be designed and issued to any retired officer of
5 the Oklahoma Highway Patrol. The license plate shall have the
6 legend "Oklahoma" and shall contain, in the center of the plate, the
7 Highway Patrol Officers patch using the same colors and pattern as
8 used in the patch. Centered on the bottom of the license plate
9 shall be the word "Retired". The letters "TRP" shall be used in
10 combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or
11 emblem. The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown.
12 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
13 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
14 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
15 deceased retired officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, if the
16 spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
17 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a Retired
18 Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers license plate. As provided in this
19 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited into the
20 Law Enforcement Retirement Fund;

21 19. Boy Scouts of America Supporter License Plate - such plates
22 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
23 support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall be issued
24 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to

1 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate
2 shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo. The Tax
3 Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a
4 licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any licensing
5 fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts of America
6 logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment
7 to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty Dollars
8 (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

9 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plate - such
10 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the
11 Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
12 Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state
13 that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and
14 beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
15 support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of
16 the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5
17 of this title;

18 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plate - such plates
19 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
20 Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and
21 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
22 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee
23 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation
24

1 Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and
2 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks;

3 22. Adoption Creates Families License Plate - such plates shall
4 be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of pregnant
5 women who are committed to placing their children for adoption and
6 wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive parents and
7 other created families to assist in the adoption and placement of
8 children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates shall be
9 designed and final terminology delivered in consultation with the
10 Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human Services.
11 Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected shall be deposited
12 in a revolving fund established in the State Treasury for and to be
13 used by the Department of Human Services for the implementation of
14 the Investing in Stronger Oklahoma Families Act specifically for
15 created families;

16 23. Choose Life License Plate - such plates shall be designed,
17 subject to criteria presented to the Tax Commission, by Choose Life,
18 Inc., and issued to any person who wishes to demonstrate support of
19 organizations that encourage adoption as a positive choice for women
20 with unplanned pregnancies. As provided in this section, an amount
21 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Choose Life
22 Assistance Program Revolving Fund established in Section 1104.6 of
23 this title;

1 24. Future Farmers of America License Plate - such plates shall
2 be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
3 the Oklahoma FFA (formerly known as Future Farmers of America). The
4 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
5 FFA Foundation Board of Directors. As provided in this section, an
6 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
7 Section 1104.7 of this title;

8 25. Lions Club License Plate - such plates shall be designed
9 and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Lions
10 Club of Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
11 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
12 as for personalized license plates. The license plates shall be
13 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation
14 and shall contain the official logo of the International Association
15 of Lions Clubs. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
16 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Lions Service
17 Foundation. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
18 the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation of not more than Ten Dollars
19 (\$10.00) for each license plate issued;

20 26. Color Oklahoma License Plate - such plates shall be
21 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
22 by the Oklahoma Native Plant Society, and issued to any person
23 wishing to demonstrate support for preserving and planting
24 wildflowers and native plants in Oklahoma and to promote Oklahoma's

wildflower heritage through education. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.8 of this title;

27. Girl Scouts of the United States of America Supporter License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Girl Scouts of the United States of America. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain the official Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the Girl Scouts of the United States of America for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Girl Scouts of Magic Empire Council, acting on behalf of all Oklahoma Girl Scout councils, of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

28. Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon. The plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon for any licensing

1 fees which may be required in order to use the Oklahoma City
2 Memorial Marathon logo or design. The licensing agreement shall
3 provide for a payment to the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon of not
4 more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

5 29. Oklahoma Scenic Rivers License Plate - such plates shall be
6 designed to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers. The
7 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Scenic
8 Rivers Commission. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee shall be
9 apportioned to the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers Commission;

10 30. Fight Cancer License Plate - such plates shall be designed
11 to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry.
12 The plate shall contain the American Cancer Society logo. The
13 American Cancer Society logo shall be used in accordance with the
14 American Cancer Society's branding guidelines and shall only be
15 utilized to support the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry. Twenty
16 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma
17 Central Cancer Registry Revolving Fund;

18 31. Animal Friendly License Plate - such plates shall be
19 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
20 controlling the overpopulation of dogs and cats through educational
21 and sterilization efforts. The plates shall be designed in
22 consultation with the Veterinary Medical Association. Twenty
23 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee collected shall be designated by the
24 purchaser of the plate to be deposited in the Oklahoma Pet

1 Overpopulation Fund created in Section 2368.13 of Title 68 of the
2 Oklahoma Statutes or the Animal Friendly Revolving Fund created in
3 Section 1104.10 of this title;

4 32. Patriot License Plate - such plates shall be designed in
5 consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma and issued to
6 any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who
7 are members of the Oklahoma National Guard and deployed on active
8 duty. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination
9 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
10 personalized license plates. As provided in this section, a portion
11 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Patriot License Plate
12 Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.11 of this title;

13 33. Global War on Terrorism License Plate - such plate shall be
14 designed in consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma
15 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma
16 residents who are members of the Armed Forces of the United States
17 or Oklahoma National Guard that have served in the Global War on
18 Terrorism. The plate shall be issued to any person in any
19 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six. As
20 provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected shall be
21 deposited in the 45th Infantry Division Museum Fund created in
22 Section 235.1 of Title 44 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

23 34. Boys and Girls Clubs of America Supporter License Plate -
24 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to

1 demonstrate support for the Boys and Girls Clubs of America. The
2 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
3 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized
4 license plates. The plate shall contain the official Boys and Girls
5 Clubs of America logo. The Tax Commission, if necessary, may enter
6 into a licensing agreement with the Boys and Girls Clubs of America
7 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
8 Boys and Girls Clubs of America logo or design. The licensing
9 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Boys and Girls Clubs of
10 America of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
11 plate issued;

12 35. Oklahoma Quarter Horse License Plate - such plates shall be
13 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
14 the American Quarter Horse in Oklahoma. The plate shall be designed
15 in consultation with the Oklahoma Quarter Horse Association. As
16 provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected shall be
17 deposited in the Oklahoma Quarter Horse Revolving Fund created in
18 Section 1104.12 of this title;

19 36. Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License Plate - such
20 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
21 Association for the Deaf and issued to any person wishing to
22 demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who are deaf. The plates
23 shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and
24 letters from one to maximum of seven, as for personalized license

1 plates. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected
2 shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License
3 Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.15 of this title;

4 37. Oklahoma City Zoo License Plate - such plates shall be
5 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
6 City Zoo. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
7 the Oklahoma Zoological Society, Inc. As provided in this section,
8 an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma
9 Zoological Society Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.13 of this
10 title;

11 38. March of Dimes License Plate - such plates shall be issued
12 to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the March of Dimes
13 mission to improve the health of babies by preventing birth defects,
14 premature birth and infant mortality. The license plates shall be
15 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter March of Dimes.
16 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
17 deposited in the Oklahoma Prevent Birth Defects, Premature Birth and
18 Infant Mortality Fund established in Section 1104.14 of this title;

19 39. Support Our Troops Supporter License Plate - such plates
20 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
21 support for Support Our Troops Incorporated. The plates shall be
22 issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from
23 one to a maximum of six. The plate shall contain the official
24 Support Our Troops Incorporated logo which includes the mark

1 "Support Our Troops" across the bottom of the plate. The Tax
2 Commission, if necessary, may enter into a licensing agreement with
3 Support Our Troops Incorporated for any licensing fees which may be
4 required in order to use the Support Our Troops Incorporated logo or
5 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
6 Support Our Troops Incorporated of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for
7 each license plate issued;

8 40. Folds of Honor Supporter License Plate - such plates shall
9 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
10 for Folds of Honor Incorporated, a nonprofit charitable organization
11 exempt from taxation pursuant to the provisions of the Internal
12 Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), providing academic and
13 vocational training scholarships to dependents of military
14 servicemen and servicewomen who were either killed or wounded in
15 action due to military service in the war in Iraq or Afghanistan.
16 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of
17 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six. The plate shall
18 be designed in consultation with Folds of Honor Incorporated and
19 shall contain the official Folds of Honor Incorporated logo which
20 includes the mark "Folds of Honor" across the bottom of the plate.
21 The Tax Commission, if necessary, may enter into a licensing
22 agreement with Folds of Honor Incorporated for any licensing fees
23 which may be required in order to use the Folds of Honor
24 Incorporated logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide

1 for a payment to Folds of Honor Incorporated of Twenty-five Dollars
2 (\$25.00) for each license plate issued;

3 41. Downed Bikers Association License Plate - such plates shall
4 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
5 for the Downed Bikers Association, a nonprofit charitable
6 organization exempt from taxation pursuant to the provisions of the
7 Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), which provides
8 emotional and financial support for downed bikers. The license
9 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Central Oklahoma
10 Chapter of the Downed Bikers Association and shall contain any
11 official logo or design of the organization. The Tax Commission, if
12 necessary, may enter into a licensing agreement with the Downed
13 Bikers Association for any licensing fees which may be required in
14 order to use the organization's logo or design. The licensing
15 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Downed Bikers
16 Association of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each
17 license plate;

18 42. Armed Forces Veterans Motorcycle License Plate - such
19 plates shall be designed for use on a motorcycle in consultation
20 with A Brotherhood Aiming Toward Education of Oklahoma, Inc.
21 (ABATE), and issued to any honorably discharged former member of the
22 United States Armed Forces wishing to demonstrate support for the
23 45th Infantry Division Museum. Persons applying for such license
24 plate must show proof of past military service. As provided in this

1 section, a portion of the fee collected shall be deposited in the
2 45th Infantry Division Museum Fund created in Section 235.1 of Title
3 44 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

4 43. Buffalo Soldier License Plate - such plates shall be issued
5 to any person wishing to honor and celebrate the history and
6 contribution of the Buffalo Soldiers. The license plates shall be
7 designed in consultation with the Lawton-Fort Sill Chapter of the
8 Buffalo Soldiers 9th and 10th (Horse) Cavalry Association. As
9 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be

12 44. Prevent Blindness Oklahoma License Plate - such plates
13 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
14 for vision screening of school age children in this state. The

1 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
2 deposited in the Pancreatic Cancer Research License Plate Revolving
3 Fund created in Section 1104.19 of this title;

4 48. Alzheimer's Research License Plate - such plates shall be
5 issued to any person wishing to provide financial support for the
6 Oklahoma Chapter of the Alzheimer's Association. The license plates
7 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of the
8 Alzheimer's Association. As provided in this section, an amount of
9 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Alzheimer's Research
10 License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.20 of this
11 title;

12 49. Hospice and Palliative Care License Plate - such plates
13 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
14 for the Oklahoma Hospice and Palliative Care Association. The
15 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma

17 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the
18 Hospice and Palliative Care License Plate Revolving Fund created in

20 50. Juvenile Diabetes Research License Plate - such plates
21 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
22 for the Oklahoma Chapters of the Juvenile Diabetes Research
23 Foundation. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
24 with the Oklahoma Chapters of the Juvenile Diabetes Research

1 Foundation. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
2 collected shall be deposited in the Juvenile Diabetes Research
3 License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.22 of this
4 title;

5 51. Deer Creek Schools Foundation License Plate - such plates
6 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
7 for the Deer Creek Schools Foundation. The license plates shall be

9 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of

11 personalized license plates. As provided in this section, an amount

2 issued to any person wishing to provide financial support for the

4 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of
5 seven, as for personalized plates. The license plates shall be
6 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Association of Chiefs of
7 Police. The license plate for a motorcycle may be of similar design
8 as space permits or a new design in order to meet the space
9 requirements of a motorcycle license plate. The Tax Commission
10 shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the
11 Oklahoma Association of Chiefs of Police for any licensing fees
12 which may be required in order to use the association's logo or
13 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the

18 54. Crossings Christian School License Plate - such plates
19 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
20 support for Crossings Christian School located in Oklahoma City.
21 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
22 administration of Crossings Christian School. The Tax Commission
23 shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with
24 Crossings Christian School for any licensing fees which may be

1 required in order to use the school's logo or design. The licensing
2 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Crossings Christian
3 School of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
4 plate issued;

5 55. Hilldale Education Foundation License Plate - such plates
6 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
7 support for the Hilldale Education Foundation. The license plates

18 shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the
19 Disabled American Veterans Department of Oklahoma for any licensing
20 fees which may be required in order to use the organization's logo
21 or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
22 the Disabled American Veterans Department of Oklahoma of not more
23 than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued. The
24 plates shall incorporate a numbering system agreed upon by the

1 Disabled American Veterans Department of Oklahoma and the Tax
2 Commission;

3 62. Owasso Rams Supporter License Plate - such plates shall be
4 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
5 the Owasso Rams, and shall be designed in consultation with
6 representatives of Owasso Schools. The plates shall be issued to
7 any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a
8 maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. As provided
9 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
10 in the Education Reform Revolving Fund created in Section 34.89 of
11 Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

12 63. Collinsville Cardinals Supporter License Plate - such
13 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
14 demonstrate support for the Collinsville Cardinals, and shall be
15 designed in consultation with representatives of Collinsville
16 Schools. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
17 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
18 as for personalized license plates. As provided in this section, an
19 amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Education
20 Reform Revolving Fund created in Section 34.89 of Title 62 of the
21 Oklahoma Statutes;

22 64. Sperry Pirates Supporter License Plate - such plates shall
23 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
24 for the Sperry Pirates, and shall be designed in consultation with

1 representatives of Sperry Schools. The plates shall be issued to
2 any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a
3 maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. As provided
4 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
5 in the Education Reform Revolving Fund created in Section 34.89 of
6 Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

7 65. Skiatook Bulldogs Supporter License Plate - such plates
8 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
9 support for the Skiatook Bulldogs, and shall be designed in
10 consultation with representatives of Skiatook Schools. The plates
11 shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and
12 letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license
13 plates. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
14 shall be deposited in the Education Reform Revolving Fund created in
15 Section 34.89 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

16 66. Rejoice Christian Eagles Supporter License Plate - such
17 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
18 demonstrate support for the Rejoice Christian Eagles, and shall be
19 designed in consultation with representatives of Rejoice Christian
20 Schools. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
21 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
22 as for personalized license plates. As provided in this section, an
23 amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Education
24

1 Reform Revolving Fund created in Section 34.89 of Title 62 of the
2 Oklahoma Statutes;

3 67. East Central Cardinals Supporter License Plate - such
4 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
5 demonstrate support for the East Central Cardinals, and shall be
6 designed in consultation with representatives of East Central
7 Schools. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
8 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
9 as for personalized license plates. As provided in this section, an
10 amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Education
11 Reform Revolving Fund created in Section 34.89 of Title 62 of the
12 Oklahoma Statutes;

13 68. Southeast Spartans Supporter License Plate - such plates
14 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
15 support for the Southeast Spartans, and shall be designed in
16 consultation with the Southeast High School Alumni Association. The
17 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
18 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized
19 license plates. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
20 collected shall be deposited in the Education Reform Revolving Fund
21 created in Section 34.89 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

22 69. Oklahoma License to Educate License Plate - subject to the
23 enactment of Senate Bill No. 15 of the 1st Session of the 56th
24 Oklahoma Legislature, such plates shall be designed and issued to

1 any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma educators.
2 Such plates shall be designed in consultation with the State
3 Department of Education. As provided in this section, an amount of
4 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Teacher
5 Recruitment Revolving Fund created in Section 2 of Senate Bill No.
6 15 of the 1st Session of the 56th Oklahoma Legislature;

7 70. Piedmont Education Foundation License Plate - such plates
8 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
9 support for the Piedmont Public Schools Education Foundation. Such
10 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Foundation. As
11 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
12 deposited in the Piedmont Education Foundation License Plate
13 Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.28 of this title;

14 71. The Pride of Oklahoma License Plate - such plates shall be
15 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
16 the University of Oklahoma Marching Band and shall be designed in
17 consultation with the University of Oklahoma Marching Band. The
18 Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a
19 licensing agreement with the University of Oklahoma or the
20 University of Oklahoma Marching Band for any licensing fees which
21 may be required in order to use the applicable logo or design. The
22 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Pride of
23 Oklahoma Fund at the University of Oklahoma Foundation, Inc. of not
24 more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

1 72. Jenks Trojans License Plate - such plates shall be designed
2 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
3 Jenks School District. The license plates shall be designed in
4 consultation with the administration of the Jenks School District.
5 The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing
6 agreement with the Jenks School District for any licensing fees
7 which may be required in order to use the school district's logo or
8 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the
9 Jenks School District of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for
10 each license plate issued;

11 73. Bixby Spartans License Plate - such plates shall be
12 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
13 the Bixby School District. The license plates shall be designed in
14 consultation with the administration of the Bixby School District.
15 The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing
16 agreement with the Bixby School District for any licensing fees
17 which may be required in order to use the school district's logo or
18 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the
19 Bixby School District of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for
20 each license plate issued;

21 74. Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission License Plate - such plates
22 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
23 support for the Oklahoma aviation industry and to promote awareness
24 of aviation and aerospace. Such plates shall be designed in

1 consultation with the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission and shall be
2 issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from
3 one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized plates. Twenty-four
4 Dollars (\$24.00) of the fee collected shall be deposited in the
5 Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission Revolving Fund, for expenditure as
6 provided in Section 91 of Title 3 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

7 75. Ducks Unlimited License Plate - such plates shall be
8 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
9 Ducks Unlimited. Such plates shall be designed in consultation with
10 Ducks Unlimited. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to
11 enter into a licensing agreement with Ducks Unlimited for any
12 licensing fee which may be required in order to use the Ducks
13 Unlimited logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for
14 a payment to Ducks Unlimited of not more than Twenty Dollars
15 (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

16 76. Prisoner of War and Missing in Action License Plate - such
17 plates shall be issued to any person wishing to increase awareness
18 of those who are currently prisoners of war or missing in action and
19 provide financial support for current veterans. The license plates
20 shall be designed in consultation with Rolling Thunder Oklahoma. As
21 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
22 deposited in the Prisoner of War and Missing in Action License Plate
23 Revolving Fund created in Section 5 of this act;

1 77. Woodward Boomers License Plate - such plates shall be
2 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
3 the Woodward School District. The license plates shall be designed
4 in consultation with the administration of the Woodward School
5 District. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a
6 licensing agreement with the Woodward School District for any
7 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the school
8 district's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
9 for a payment to the Woodward School District of not more than
10 Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued; and

11 78. Clinton Public School Foundation License Plate - such
12 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
13 demonstrate support for the Clinton Public School Foundation. The
14 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Clinton
15 Public School Foundation. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to
16 enter into a licensing agreement with the Clinton Public School
17 Foundation for any licensing fees which may be required in order to
18 use the school foundation's logo or design. The licensing agreement
19 shall provide for a payment to the Clinton Public School Foundation
20 of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate
21 issued.

22 C. The fee for such plates shall be Thirty-five Dollars
23 (\$35.00) per year of renewal and shall be in addition to all other
24

1 registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
2 Registration Act. The fee shall be apportioned as follows:

3 1. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) per year of renewal or any other
4 amount as provided in this title of the fee shall be apportioned as
5 provided or deposited in a fund as specified within the paragraph
6 authorizing the special license plate;

7 2. Eight Dollars (\$8.00) per year of renewal of the fee shall
8 be deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be
9 used for the administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
10 Registration Act; and

11 3. Any remaining amounts of the fee shall be apportioned as
12 provided in Section 1104 of this title.

13 SECTION 6. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
