HOUSE BILL 3440

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; imposing requirement with respect to expenditure of funds distributed by the Commissioners of the Land Office; requiring expenditure of funds for purposes of teacher pay increase; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 18-501 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019, and for each fiscal year thereafter, and pursuant to the provisions of Section 3 of Article XI of the Oklahoma Constitution and other applicable provisions of law, the Commissioners of the Land Office shall provide a Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) pay increase with monies received by a common school district to teachers with the professional staff distribution code of 210. This money shall be

1 expended by those districts exclusively and shall not be used for
2 any other purpose.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2018.

4 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
6 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
