AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to state government; allowing  
Legislators to return to certain employment;  
providing exception; providing for codification; and  
providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 250.4b of Title 74, unless there  
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A state employee that leaves employment with the state to become  
an elected member of the Legislature shall retain the right to  
return to his or her previous state employment at the same salary he  
or she previously earned, immediately upon leaving the Legislature;  
unless otherwise provided by law.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
