HOUSE BILL 3592

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to higher education; requiring certain funds to remain with student for certain period; requiring funds to be available for other students after end of certain period; requiring Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education to promulgate certain rules; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2606 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. If a student withdraws from a class in which he or she has received an award from the Oklahoma Higher Learning Access Program, the awarded funds shall remain available for the student to use to enroll in classes for a five-year period. If the student does not use the awarded funds during the five-year period, the funds shall be available for use for other students in the Oklahoma Higher Learning Access Program.

1 B. The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education shall  
2 promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this section.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
