16	Section 8005. A. The state agency which has undergone an
17	independent comprehensive performance audit shall may implement the
18	recommendations of the Agency Performance and Accountability
19	Commission as concluded from the independent comprehensive
20	performance audit.
21	B. Not later than twelve (12) months after the completion of
22	the independent comprehensive performance audit, the Commission
23	shall review the implementation of the recommendations in the audit.

C. The Commission shall issue a report regarding the extent to
which the agency has or has not implemented the recommendations of
the audit. The follow-up report shall be submitted to the Governor,
President Pro Tempore of the Senate and Speaker of the House of
Representatives. The report shall be made publicly available on the
Oklahoma State Legislature's website and documents.ok.gov.
```

The state agency shall be required to provide an explanation D. or justification for any failure to implement the recommendations of an independent comprehensive performance audit.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
