1	from sexual, domestic and interpersonal violence, developed the
2	Honor Denim Day campaign in response to the Italian Supreme Court
3	case and the activism surrounding it; and
4	WHEREAS, wearing jeans on Honor Denim Day has become a symbol of
5	protest against erroneous and destructive attitudes about sexual
6	assault.
7	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
8	OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 56TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE
9	CONCURRING THEREIN:
10	THAT the Oklahoma Legislature designates April 26, 2017, as
11	"Honor Denim Day" in the State of Oklahoma.
12	THAT the Oklahoma Legislature recognizes the importance of
13	promoting awareness about the misconceptions of sexual violence,
14	educating the community about the importance of prevention and
15	facilitating dialogue on how to be a supportive ally to survivors of
16	sexual violence.
