8	A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State to refer to the people for their approval or
9	rejection a proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma by amending Section 8E of
10	Article X; extending the homestead exemption to veterans who have received certain compensation;
11	providing ballot title; and directing filing.

14	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE
15	2ND SESSION OF THE 56TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
16	SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
17	their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
18	the following proposed amendment to Section 8E of Article X of the
19	Constitution of the State of Oklahoma to read as follows:
20	Section 8E. A. Despite any provision to the contrary,
21	beginning January 1, 2006, each head of household shall be entitled
22	to claim an exemption for the full amount of the fair cash value of
23	the homestead who has been honorably discharged from active service

in any branch of the Armed Forces of the United States or Oklahoma National Guard and who $\frac{1}{2}$

- 1. Has been certified by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs or its successor to have a one hundred percent (100%) permanent disability sustained through military action or accident or resulting from disease contracted while in such active service;
- 2. Has received compensation or awarded a judgment, settlement or compromise pursuant to Section 1151 of Title 38 of the United States Code; or
- 3. Is the surviving spouse of such the head of household shall be entitled to claim an exemption for the full amount of the fair cash value of the homestead.
- B. In order to be eligible for the exemption authorized by this section, the individual shall be required to prove residency within the State of Oklahoma and must have previously qualified for the homestead exemption authorized by law or be eligible for the homestead exemption pursuant to law.
- C. If a homestead otherwise eligible for the exemption authorized by this section is transferred on or after January 1 of a calendar year, another homestead property acquired by the qualifying head of household or by the surviving spouse of such qualifying head of household shall be exempt to the same extent as the homestead property previously owned by such person or persons for the year
