L 7	SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
L8	their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
L 9	the following proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of
20	Oklahoma by adding a new Section 3.1 to Article VI, to read as
21	follows:
22	Section 3.1 Beginning with the General Election held in 2022
23	and in each General Election for Governor and Lieutenant Governor
24	held thereafter, the candidates for a political party shall run on

1 the same ticket with one vote to be cast for the candidates for those positions. The candidate for Governor for each political 3 party shall designate an individual to run as the nominee for Lieutenant Governor for the party. The designation may be made at 5 any time after the candidate for Governor is declared to be the candidate for Governor for the political party but must be 6 7 communicated to the State Election Board in a timely manner to provide the Board with sufficient time to print ballots for the General Election. Each Independent candidate shall designate an 10 individual to run on the same ticket as the candidate. The 11 Legislature, by law, may provide additional procedures for the joint 12 nomination and election of candidates for Governor and Lieutenant 1.3 Governor.

SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in the following form:

This measure amends the Oklahoma Constitution. It adds a new Section 3.1 to Article 6. It deals with the Offices of Governor and Lieutenant Governor. It would provide that a voter would cast one vote for both of these offices. The persons running for these offices would run as a team. The
