13	rule entitled the "Veterinary Feed Directive" was enacted on
14	October 1, 2015; and
15	WHEREAS, under these regulations, a livestock farmer,
16	rancher, or animal producer could only use certain
17	antibiotics with the authorization of a veterinarian in the
18	form of a directive; and
19	WHEREAS, the Veterinary Feed Directive dramatically
20	changed the process of accessing and administering
21	antibiotics to livestock as well as the relationship among
22	veterinarians, feed suppliers and farmers; and
23	WHEREAS, the Veterinary Feed Directive has caused
24	hardships for Oklahoma farmers and ranchers, putting

livestock in inhumane circumstances as their care is delayed or in some cases unattainable; and

Whereas, Oklahoma farmers and ranchers are devoted to continuing to produce the safest food supply in the entire world, supplying completely antibiotic-free meat to consumers

worldwide; and

WHEREAS, Oklahoma farmers and ranchers are committed to raising healthy animals through the judicious use of antibiotics in giving care to their animals; and

WHEREAS, Oklahoma farmers and ranchers are capable to prevent most disease with the used of antimicrobials; and

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma House of Representatives believes that Oklahomans are the most qualified to determine health, safety, and well-being of the animals under their care through medicated and nonmedicated feed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 56TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives urges the repeal of the Veterinary Feed Directive and hereby encourages the Oklahoma Congressional Delegation and the United States Congress to support the repeal of the Veterinary Feed Directive.
