AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution commending Project31 for its important work with those diagnosed with breast cancer; and recognizing Breast Cancer Day at the Capitol.

WHEREAS, breast cancer is the most frequently diagnosed cancer among Oklahoma women and is the leading cause of cancer death among women according to the State Health Department; and

WHEREAS, 3,212 new cases of breast cancer were diagnosed among women in Oklahoma in 2014; and

WHEREAS, the toll of breast cancer is not limited solely to the body as it can cause emotional and spiritual damage; and

WHEREAS, Project31 was founded to focus on the reconstruction that is often necessary for the heart, spirit and relationships of those diagnosed with breast cancer, receiving treatments, and in recovery; and

WHEREAS, Project31 provides support for every part of the journey including offering financial scholarships for professional

1 counseling, weekly support groups with locations in Oklahoma City
2 and Tulsa, and one-on-one mentoring relationships.
