NEW LAW A new section of law not to be 4 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows: 5 For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, the Oklahoma 6 Department of Public Safety shall not impose restrictions on the 7 number of miles which vehicles provided by the Department of Public 8 Safety and driven by state troopers may travel and shall not reduce 9 the amount of fuel available for consumption by such vehicles or in 10 any other manner restrict the range of travel by such vehicles. 11 SECTION 3.
