COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to the State Department of Health;
directing the Department to submit certain report to
the Legislature by certain date; stating contents of
report; providing for noncodification; and declaring
an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

The State Department of Health shall submit a corrective action
report to the Legislature by January 1, 2018. The corrective action
report shall identify completed cost reductions, business processes
and efficiencies to meet core public health services and
recommendations for improved financial controls at the State

1 Department of Health that shall result in a fifteen percent (15%)
2 reduction in state appropriations by June 30, 2019.

3 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
4 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
5 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
6 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
