COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to the Department of Corrections;  
requiring that portions of certain appropriated funds  
be used for certain purposes; requiring certain  
coordination; providing an effective date; and  
declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Department of  
Corrections in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1600 of the 2nd Session of  
the 56th Oklahoma Legislature, the Department shall utilize adequate  
amounts to maintain a per diem rate of not less than Forty-three  
Dollars and thirty cents (\$43.30) for private prison medium security  
beds for the period beginning July 1, 2018, and ending June 30,  
2019.

1       SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the Department of  
2 Corrections in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1600 of the 2nd Session of  
3 the 56th Oklahoma Legislature, the Department shall utilize up to  
4 Four Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$4,800,000.00) to  
5 coordinate with the Office of Management and Enterprise Services in  
6 the implementation of a statewide offender management system.

7       SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2018.

8       SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
9 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
10 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
11 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
