COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Department of  
Commerce; requiring that portions of certain  
appropriated funds be used for certain purposes;  
providing an effective date; and declaring an  
emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma  
Department of Commerce in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1600 of the 2nd  
Session of the 56th Oklahoma Legislature, the Department of Commerce  
shall spend Four Hundred Forty-five Thousand Dollars (\$445,000.00)  
to implement the provisions of Enrolled House Bill No. 2578 of the  
2nd Session of the 56th Oklahoma Legislature.

SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma  
Department of Commerce in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1600 of the 2nd

1 Session of the 56th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Hundred  
2 Forty Thousand Seven Hundred Forty-two Dollars (\$140,742.00) shall  
3 be transferred to the Seminole State College Rural Business and  
4 Resources Center.

5 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2018.

6 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
7 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
