19	Million One Hundred Eighty-five Thousand Dollars (\$60,185,000.00) to
20	be transferred to the Ad Valorem Reimbursement Fund, created
21	pursuant to Section 193 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes, for
22	the purpose of reimbursing counties for school districts that claim
23	a loss of revenue due to a tax exemption granted pursuant to the
24	provisions of Section 6B of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution,
