SENATE BILL 842

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the State Department of Education;
making an appropriation; making appropriation
nonfiscal; making appropriation exempt from certain
agency category and budget limits; providing an
effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of
Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
Constitutional Reserve Fund of the State Treasury the sum of Sixty
Million One Hundred Eighty-five Thousand Dollars (\$60,185,000.00) to
be transferred to the Ad Valorem Reimbursement Fund, created
pursuant to Section 193 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes, for
the purpose of reimbursing counties for school districts that claim
a loss of revenue due to a tax exemption granted pursuant to the
provisions of Section 6B of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution,

1 pursuant to paragraph 8 of Section 23 of Article X of the Oklahoma
2 Constitution.

3 SECTION 2. The appropriation made by this act shall not be
4 subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for
5 encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30)
6 months from the date this act is approved.

7 SECTION 3. The appropriations made by this act shall not be
8 subject to fiscal years 2017 and 2018 agency category and budget
9 limits.

10 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective June 15, 2017.

11 SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
12 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
13 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
14 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
