**Research Analysis**

The PCS for HB 1001 requires the appropriations committee in the House and Senate to present general appropriations bills that reflect substantially the available revenue as certified by the State Equalization Board. The measure requires both chambers to hold a vote on the bills not more than 15 days nor less than 7 days apart. Finally, if the Legislature fails to comply with these requirements, the Speaker of the House is directed to present the Governor's budget bill to the House and, if approved, the bill will go directly to the Senate for a vote on final passage without amendment.
