**Research Analysis**

The introduced measure permits students in grades nine through twelve who transfer schools, as per the Education Open Transfer Act and before the fifth day of the receiving school's academic year, to participate in extramural competitions governed by the Oklahoma Secondary School Activities Association. Such participation will be allowed for one transfer per academic unless an emergency transfer is granted. Lastly, the measure repeals the section of law governing student transfers and their ability to participate in extramural athletic competitions.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 1007, as introduced, provides language to allow students in grades 9-12 with specified transfer, to be eligible to participate in school-related extramural competitions governed by the Oklahoma Secondary School Activities Association. The measure provides for a repeal of a section of law on extramural athletic competition for transfer student not residing in district. The measure is anticipated to have no fiscal impact.
