The ODWC would note the proposed restrictions on the abilities of Game Wardens, which ultimately could lead to illegal hunting and a decline in game animals in our state. This, in turn, could result in decreased interest in hunting, and decreased sales of hunting licenses. According to ODWC, however, there is no quantifiable model or estimate for this impact.
