Research Analysis

HB 1027x directs that the Department of Public Safety is not to reduce the salary of any state trooper, impose furloughs on state troopers, or take any other action to reduce the total time a state trooper is available for the performance of law enforcement duties. The measure also prohibits the department from imposing restrictions on the number of miles driven by troopers or on the amount of fuel available for trooper vehicles.
