OMES Continues to Produce Salary Ranges

**Prohibits Payroll Processing in Excess
of Salary Limits**

Research Analysis

The measure directs that the salary of a chief executive officer of a state agency be determined by his or her appointing authority and prohibits the Office of Management and Enterprise Services from processing payroll in excess of the salary limits recommended in the annual compensation reports.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure provides that salaries of chief executive officers for agencies and departments is to be determined by the appointing authority of the chief executive officer, set between the minimum and maximum of a range specified in annual compensation reports. The measure also prohibits the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) to process payroll in excess of the salary limits recommended in the annual compensation reports. Actual salaries will depend on the applicable salary ranges set in future annual compensation reports and decisions made by the appointing authority of the chief executive officer.
