**Fiscal Analysis**

Analysis completed by the State Department of Education indicates the salary increases for the certified personnel identified in the measure will result in cost of approximately \$287,849,265, with additional costs for qualifying teachers within the Office of Juvenile Affairs, Schools for the Deaf and Blind, Corrections and Career Technology, with a preliminary estimated cost of approximately \$8.0 million.
