The committee substitute to HB 1104 would allow elected officials of a county, who are in possession of a valid handgun license issued pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act, when acting in the performance of their duties as an elected official to carry a firearm within the courthouses of the county in which he or she was elected. The county official would not be allowed to carry into a courtroom.
