Research Analysis

HB 1110 provides Professional Employer Organizations (PEO) with a tax credit if taxable wages were reported by a client, in a previous account of the client, within the calendar year that a PEO is set up. The measure also updates and clarifies statutory language. Finally, the bill repeals 40 OS 3-809, relating to group accounts within the Employment Security Act of 1980.
